

# 2024 ATLANTIC CLASS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP MADISON BEACH CLUB, MADISON CT August 14 – 16, 2024

# NOTICE OF RACE (Version 2/5/24)



The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Atlantic Class Association and hosted by the Madison Beach Club in Madison, CT. Principal Race Officer is Amanda Clark.

# 1 RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2021-2024 including US Sailing Prescriptions
- 1.2 In addition to the Rules of the Atlantic Class Association that are available on the Atlantic Class website.
- 1.3 Atlantic Class Equipment Regulations will apply, except where altered by the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4 Parking at MBC property is limited, no trailers on the property.

# **2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 2.1. Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available online August 11th.
- 2.2. In the case of a discrepancy between the NOR and SI, the SI will prevail.
- 2.3. The race committee reserves the right to amend the SI at any time, with proper notice to the competitors.

# **3 COMMUNICATION**

- 3.1 The online notice board is located on the Yacht Scoring site as well as MBC sailing bulletin board
- 3.2 All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on standard channels.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee (RC) will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors via VHF radio. The channel will be stated on the SIs.
- 3.4 While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or transmission and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

#### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 Event is open to all boats of the Atlantic Class that conform to the current Atlantic Class Rules.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form and paying the required fees
- 4.3 All participants, including those who registered and made the required payments online, are required to report to Check-In during the scheduled hours to confirm and complete their registration.
- 4.4 All competitors must complete waivers online no later than Aug 1st

# 5 FEES

- 5.1 Entry fee (taxes included) is as follows:
  - \$1,100 if paid online by June 1, 2024, or \$1,200 after June 1 and before Aug 1
- 5.2. An entry will not be considered final until all fees are paid, and all required forms are submitted no later than August 1, 2024

#### 6 CREW LIMITATIONS

6.1 Per the Atlantic Class Rules.

# **8 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION**

All competing boats must provide the following:

a) Completed **Measurement Certificate waiver**, found in Yacht Scoring, signed by Atlantic Rules Committee member no later than Aug 1<sup>st</sup>

- b) Boats, equipment and sails may be inspected at any time.
- c) Repairs, alteration or substitution of sails or equipment shall be in accordance with Atlantic Class rules and will require the written content of the OA, Protest Committee or the PRO

#### 9 VENUE

The racing area will be on Long Island Sound, the waters off the Madison Beach Club, Madison, CT. Boat launch and haul is at Browns Boatyard, see **Additional Information** for details.

# 10 PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 Per the Atlantic Class rules

#### 11 SCORING.

- 12.1. Six races are scheduled.
- 12.2 Three completed races are necessary to constitute a regatta.
- 12.3 A boat's worst score shall be excluded if 5 or more races are completed.

# 12 CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS

A chartered or loaned boat, all conditions regarding 'Eligibility and Entry' shall apply.

#### 13 BERTHING

15.1. All boats shall be kept on their assigned mooring.

#### 14 RISK STATEMENT

- 16.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone'.
- 16.2 The skipper is required to sign the **MBC Risk & Responsibility** on Yacht Scoring as part of completing the registration no later than Aug 1st.

# 15 INSURANCE

- 18.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000 USD per incident or the equivalent. It is the owner's inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate prior to competing in the event.
- 18.2. Proof of Insurance shall be provided no later than Aug 1st

# 16 PRIZES

19.1. The Atlantic Class perpetual trophies will be presented to the winners at the Atlantic Class annual dinner, along with the Atlantic Nationals keeper prizes for 1st through 5th places.

19.2 Additional prizes may be awarded.
