NOTICE OF RACE

Poor Memorial Race Sunday, August 31, 2014

Organizing Authority: The Shelter Island Yacht Club

- **1. Rules**: The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2013-2016, and the US Sailing Association Prescriptions, except as changed by this notice, the ELIYA General Conditions and the 2014 Poor Memorial Race Sailing Instructions.
- **2.** Classes: The Race is open to all PHRF class boats with a current, **2014**, PHRF-ELI Certificate, and that can demonstrate compliance with all requirements of the certificate. There will be both spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes, divided in accordance with the 2014 Poor Memorial Race Sailing Instructions.

Entrants are encouraged to display the code flag for their division from the backstay to facilitate identification by other entrants and the Race Committee.

Note: If at least three boats of a one design class enter to race, using the class one design rating, they will be scored as a class as well as within the appropriate division, e.g., J105s racing as a class as well as in division I.

- **3. Scoring**: PHRF, Time on Time Scoring.
- **4. Start Times**: (See RRS, Part 3, 26 Starting Races)

The first warning signal will be at **1100**. The warning signal for subsequent classes shall be made with or after the starting signal of the preceding class.

- **5.** The Start: Between an Orange Flag on the Race Committee Boat and a red ball or an inflatable mark set to the south of Fl. Red Buoy 16 in Noyack Bay.
- **6.** The Finish: Between an Orange Flag on the Race Committee Boat and a red ball, inflatable mark or Government mark set in the location indicated under courses in the Sailing Instructions.
- **7.** Courses: Courses in detail will be included in the Sailing Instructions. Weather and current permitting the course will be counter clockwise around Shelter Island and will finish in the vicinity of the start, south of FL Red Buoy 16 in Noyack Bay. However, the Race Committee may elect to provide a different course for **all or some** divisions.

- **8. Sailing Instructions**: The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Shelter Island YC one week prior to the race, on www.yachtscoring.com or from the Committee Boat on the day of the race.
- **9. Communications**: The Race Committee will monitor Channels 72.
- **10 Time Limit**: Five hours from the start time for **each** division.

11. Entries: Entry fee: \$50.00.

Entries <u>must</u> be made on <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u> . Please do not neglect to indicate in which Division you intend to race and to sign the waiver.

A copy of the boat's 2014 PHRF-ELI certificate must be received by the race committee before an entry will be considered final.

12 Entries: Entries must be made by Wednesday, August 27, 2014.
