BRISA, the Organizing Committee of the Caribbean International Boat Show and Puerto del Rey Marina have the distinct pleasure of inviting you to the *3rd Ulysse Nardin Festival of Sails* to be held on March 22-23, 2014. Our sponsors are honored to offer the sailors from Puerto Rico and the Caribbean an awesome weekend of sailing competition and a spectacular festive environment during the largest Boat Show presented in the Caribbean.

1. RULES

- 1.1. This Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). To the extent permitted by Part 7 of the RRS, specific provisions of the RRS may be modified, altered or made inoperative by the Notice of Race (NOR) or the Sailing Instructions (SI).
- 1.2. Rules of participating One Design classes will apply, except as modified, altered or made inoperative by the NOR or the SI, to the extent permitted by such class rules.
- 1.3. Boats in Jib and Main Class have to sail with one headsail only. The use of spinnaker pole is allowed.
- 1.4. Genoas more than 150% will not be allowed in Cruising and Jib & Main classes.
- 1.5. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats with a minimum LOA of 19 feet and IC 24 Class, J-24 Class, Jib and Main, and any other class. A minimum of three (3) boats for each class is required to constitute a class.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form making complete payment of the registration fee through www.yachtscoring.com
- 2.3. Classes/Categories: The acceptance of yachts in a specific class/categories is entirely at the discretion of the Regatta Committee (RC). Classes/categories will generally be arranged according to rating and will be announced at the Skippers Meeting.
- 2.4. There may be up to 10 (ten) categories for entry.

- 2.5. All CSA Racing boats must have a valid 2014 CSA Certification that will be reviewed by the Race Committee. A CSA measurer will be available to measure boats and issue CSA certificates for two days prior and during the event. The cost of the having a measurer present is included in the CSA registration fee. This fee does not cover the cost of the CSA certificate, which will be billed by the measurer and is payable in cash at the time of measurement.
- 2.6. All Jib and Main and RAYA class boats will be assigned a PHRF rating
- 2.7. The Race Committee reserves the right to waive eligibility to vessels and/or to consolidate categories in order to allow fair and maximum participation.
- 2.8. * J24 and IC 24 may only race one design in their respective classes. If class minimums are not met, BRISA will refund any entry fees paid.

3. REGISTRATION FEES:

3.1. Registration fee includes free entry to the Caribbean Boat Show, dock, music, parties and social activities

5.1. Entering yachts are encouraged to carry on board a current copy of NOAA charts 25663 and 25667. MUST BECOME FAMILIAR WITH LOCAL SHOAL, REEF AND CHANNELS.

7. MARINA ACCOMMODATIONS

- 7.1. FREE SLIP or trailer yard space will be provided from the Friday, March 21st to Tuesday, March 25th. Please, make proper arrangements directly with Puerto de Rey Marina by phone, (787) 860-1000 or email marina@puertodelrey.com
- 7.2. Puerto del Rey Marina will assign a slip according to LOA and draft of the yacht. Yachts that are racing must dock at their assigned space in order to receive prizes. The Marina reserves the right to remove any boat to another slip according the availability of space. While the boat is at the facilities, you must check the weather conditions daily. In case inclement weather you may be required to move your boat.

9. IDENTIFICATION OF SAILS / BOATS

9.1. Each boat should provide a clearly visible, unique, non-repeated form of identification on its sail or hull. In the case of a duplicate number the last boat to be registered should modify his before the first warning signal in order to participate in the races.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

10.1. The sailing instructions will be available upon registration and will be published in the on www.yachtscoring.com.

11. VENUE

- 11.1. The venue of this event is the Puerto del Rey Marina, at Fajardo, Puerto Rico, and adjacent waters.
- 11.2. The Race will take place in the navigational waters of "Rada de Fajardo" and adjacent waters.

12. SCORING

- 12.1. A minimum of one (1) race will constitute a regatta.
- 12.2. When 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 12.3. In the event that between 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13. PRIZES

- 13.1. One Ulysse Nardin watch will be awarded to the Overall Winner of the Racing Class. A Techno Marine watch will be awarded to the overall winner of the Jib and Main Classes. A Techno Marine watch will be raffled among the winners of IC24, J24, Nativos and Chalana classes.
- 13.2. The BRISA Cup trophy for the Overall Winner in the KISS (RAYA) Category, and trophies and surprises to the first three competitors of each class/category and to the best dressed team and best looking boat at the dock. An Award Ceremony is scheduled for 1700 hours, March 23, 2014 at the designated area.
