Amendment #1 to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

- 1.3 (ii) T2.2 is deleted and replaced with
(ii) T2.2 Post-Race Penalty shall be 30% if taken before a protest hearing involving the incident.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.2 Flag AP displayed with 2 sounds means "The race is postponed for all Cruising Boats. The first warning signal will be made not less than 60 minutes after flag AP is lowered.
- 4.3 Flag AP over Flag W with 2 sounds means "The race is postponed for the One Design course. The first warning signal will be made not less than 60 minutes after flags AP over W are lowered."
- 4.4 Flag AP over Flag E with 2 sounds means "The race is postponed for the Centerboard course. The first warning signal will be made not less than 60 minutes after flags AP over E are lowered."

5 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 5.1 Saturday, September 6
- 0955 First Warning Cruising Boats
 - 1055 First Warning One Design Boats
 - 1125 First Warning for the Centerboard Boats
 - 1600 No warning signal after this time
Awards ceremony after racing
 - 1800 Family Pig Roast and Silent Auction in the Pandemonium

8 COURSES

- 8.3 Should read : Windward-Leeward, Courses 22 through 66.

Course:

- 22** Consisting of 2 legs – windward, finish to leeward.
- 33** Consisting of 3 legs – windward, leeward, finish to windward.
- 44** Consisting of 4 legs – windward, leeward, windward, finish to leeward.
- 55** Consisting of 5 legs – windward, leeward, windward, leeward, finish to windward.
- 66** Consisting of 6 legs – windward, leeward, windward, leeward, windward, finish to leeward.

9 TIME LIMIT

- 9.1 The time limit for all distance races will be 1700. Boats failing to finish within the time limit will be scored DNF.
- 9.2 The time limit for Windward-Leeward courses will be 2.5 hours. Boats failing to finish within 30 minutes after the first boat in that division sails the course and finishes will be scored “Time Limit Expired” (TLE). This changes rule 35.

10 MARKS

- 10.1 Rounding marks for courses 22 through 66 will be orange inflatable marks, except as provided under sailing instruction 13.
- 10.2 The race committee may elect to give some classes a substantially shorter windward leg than what is posted for the other classes. If it does so, it will announce its intentions on VHF channel 73 and will post the number “0” on the signal board next to that Class signifying a shorter windward leg for those classes. The mark will be a white inflatable. A change of course mark will be the same white mark.

12 RECALLS

The race committee will endeavor to identify recalled boats by broadcasting their sail numbers over VHF channel 73 and/or loudhailer. Failure of a boat to hear her recall notification or the order of boats recalled shall not be grounds for redress.
