Amendment to "6 -- Courses":

Previously read:

Saturday -- Traverse City to Northport (27.1 nm)

Sections 1 & 2:

1. Start: between GTYC Committee Boat & orange ball directly in front of GTYC, single start for all divisions
2. Red "8" to Port
3. Green C7 to Port
4. Red "4" to Starboard
5. Mission Point Light to Port
6. Red "2" to Port
7. Bellows Island to Starboard
8. Finish with Northport Red N"6" to Starboard, bearing 270 degrees (details at Skippers Meeting)

Section 3 (22.8 nm):

1. Start: between GTYC Committee Boat & orange ball directly in front of GTYC, single start for all divisions
2. Red "8" to Port
3. Mission Point Light to Port
3. Bellows Island to Starboard
4. Finish with Northport Red N"6" to Starboard, bearing 270 degrees (details at Skippers Meeting)

Sunday – Northport to Traverse City -- All Divisions (21.5 nm)

1. Start at Northport Lighted Bell Buoy "6" (RC or Committee Boat to be named Race Weekend), single start for all divisions
2. Leave C"7" to Starboard

3. Leave R "8" to Starboard
4. Finish between the GTYC dock and orange marker (please keep clear of the mooring area) and record your own finish time, contact gtyc.rc@gmail.com or msg 231.883.5741 with the boat ahead and boat behind.

Changed to read:

Saturday -- Traverse City to Northport

Yachts shall declare prior to start their intent to sail either the "Long Course" or the "Short Course"

"Long Course" (27.1 nm):

1. Start: between GTYC Committee Boat & orange ball directly in front of GTYC, single start for all divisions
2. Red "8" to Port
3. Green C7 to Port
4. Red "4" to Starboard
5. Mission Point Light to Port
6. Red "2" to Port
7. Bellows Island to Starboard
8. Finish with Northport Red N"6" to Starboard, bearing 270 degrees (details at Skippers Meeting)

"Short Course" (22.8 nm):

1. Start: between GTYC Committee Boat & orange ball directly in front of GTYC, single start for all divisions
2. Red "8" to Port
3. Mission Point Light to Port
3. Bellows Island to Starboard
4. Finish with Northport Red N"6" to Starboard, bearing 270 degrees (details at Skippers Meeting)

Sunday – Northport to Traverse City -- All Divisions (21.5 nm)

1. Start at Northport R N "6" (RC or Committee Boat to be named Race Weekend), single start for all divisions
2. Leave C"7" to Starboard

3. Leave R "8" to Starboard
4. Finish between the GTYC dock and orange marker (please keep clear of the mooring area) and record your own finish time, contact gtyc.rc@gmail.com or msg 231.883.5741.

Amendment to "7 -- Shorten Course"

Previously read:

7 – SHORTEN COURSE – In the event a "Experienced" division yacht has not rounded Old Mission Lighthouse on Saturday by 3:00 pm, the course will be ended at the Old Mission Lighthouse. On Sunday, if a yacht has not rounded C7 on Saturday by 3:00 pm, the course will be ended at R8. Each yacht shall take her own time in accordance with the "Scoring" section above at the moment her bow passes due east of the northernmost edge of the Old Mission Lighthouse crib, or on Sunday, passes due east of the southernmost edge of C7. In the event of a shortened course, an announcement will be broadcast on a VHF Channel 69.

Amend to read:

7 – SHORTEN COURSE

Saturday -- TVC-NPT: In the event the leading yacht on either course has not rounded Old Mission Lighthouse on Saturday by 3:00 pm, the course will be ended at the Old Mission Lighthouse. Each yacht shall take her own time in accordance with the "Scoring" section above at the moment her bow passes due east of the northernmost edge of the Old Mission Lighthouse crib. Please record and report your accordingly. In the event of a shortened course, the leading yacht shall broadcast their finish on VHF Channel 69.

Sunday -- NPT-TVC: In the event the leading yacht has not rounded G C 7 on Sunday by 3:00 pm, the course will be ended at G C 7. Each yacht shall take her own time in accordance with the "Scoring" section above at the moment her bow passes due east (90 degrees) of the northernmost edge of the green can. Please record and report your accordingly. In the event of a shortened course, the leading yacht shall broadcast their finish on VHF Channel 69.
