## Addendum #2

Allocation of Fleets and Schedule of Races for the Qualifying Races and the Gold / Silver Championship Series

## Friday, August 1st: Qualifying Races.

- 1.1. Skipper's Meeting for all Qualifying Races competitors at 10:45 on the Patio.
- 1.2 The Organizing Authority will divide skippers (except for the Sat / Sun only competitors) into three (3) flights, with each flight designated by a color (Blue, Black and Yellow).

A list showing each boat's flight and color assignment will be posted as follows:

a) at www.yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=1123 (posted prior to the regatta).

Flight assignments will be posted on the "Official Notice Board" located on the website as well as on the "Scratch Sheet" link

- b) At ABYC on the glass wall facing the boat basin.
- 1.3 Colored Flight Ribbons will be distributed at registration. All ribbons must be attached to the outboard end of the boat's boom and be easily visible.
- 1.4 The Warning Signal for the first Qualifying race will be at 1145. Races are scheduled to run consecutively with limited delays. Each boat racing in the next start should proceed to the starting area immediately after finishing.

There will be no formal lunch break. Competitors should eat prior to racing, or during their bye races. Please use the restrooms during your bye race in a timely manner.

1.5 Order of starts by Flights – Qualifying Races:

Race One: Blue - Black Bye: Yellow

Race Two: Black - Yellow Bye: Blue

Race Three: Blue - Yellow Bye: Black

Race Four: Blue - Black Bye: Yellow

Race Five: Black - Yellow Bye: Blue

Race Six: Blue - Yellow Bye: Black

## Saturday, August 2 & Sunday August 3: Championship Regatta

- 2.1 Skipper's Meeting for all competitors at 10:30 on the Patio.
- 2.2 A list showing the Gold and Silver flight participants will be posted on the Official Notice Board and on the regatta website prior to 10:00 am on Saturday morning.
- 2.3 Gold and Silver Fleets' Ribbons, as described below, will be distributed at Saturday's Skippers' Meeting. All ribbons must be attached to the outboard end of the boat's boom and be easily visible. Ribbons from the Qualifying Races must be removed. The two championship fleets will be identified as follows:

Gold Fleet -Yellow Ribbon

Silver Fleet – Blue Ribbon

- 2.4 The Warning Signal for the first Gold fleet race will be at 1130.
- 2.5 Order of starts on Saturday and Sunday by Fleets Championship Series:

Gold Fleet Races 1-3, followed by:

Silver Fleet Races 1 – 3, followed by:

Gold Fleet Races 4 – 6, followed by:

Silver Fleet Races 4 – 6, followed by:

Gold Fleet Races 7 – 9, followed by:

Silver Fleet Races 7 – 9, followed by:

Gold Fleet Races 10 – 12, followed by

Silver Fleet Races 10 – 12

Boats racing in the next start should proceed to the starting area immediately after finishing. Following their 3<sup>rd</sup> race of a rotation, they may return to ABYC.

2.6 The race committee will attempt to announce at ABYC the timing for the "onshore fleet's" next race. The Warning Signal for the next Fleet to sail may be prior to all boats from the previous fleet having finished.

IT IS EACH BOAT'S SOLE RESPONSIBILITY TO BE OUT ON THE COURSE AND READY TO START RACING NO LATER THAN THE TIME THE OTHER FLEET IS FINISHING THEIR 3<sup>rd</sup> RACE OF THEIR ROTATION.

2.7 On Sunday at 11:30, the rotation of races will continue from the point that racing was stopped on Saturday.

For instance, if the Gold fleet has sailed only two races of its rotation when racing ended on Saturday, then they will sail the first race on Sunday and come in.... or if Saturday's racing ended with it being the Silver fleet's turn to race, then the silver fleet will begin the racing on Sunday.

The fleet to start out on the water on Sunday will be posted on the Official Notice Board by 10:00 on Sunday morning.

2.8 On Sunday, no Warning Signal will be made after 3:30.
