### **RULES**

The Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the regulations of the Caribbean Sailing Association (CSA), the CSA Minimum Safety Requirements, the Virgin Islands Sailing Association (VISA), and IC-24 class rules, except as any of those are changed by the sailing instructions. The Regatta is designated Category C.

Eligibility requirement for boats is a current CSA rating, except for Multihulls and one design classes.
