NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1 The Regatta will be covered by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and the Olson 30 Class Rules. In the event of a conflict in translation, the English version will prevail.

1.2 All competitors and boats must adhere to the Olson 30 Class Association Rules. http://www.olson30.org/association/olson-30-class-constitution

2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1 This Regatta is open to all Olson 30 Class Association members and their crew. Join the Olson 30 Class http://www.olson30.org/association/membership-application

2.2 Entry fee for this event has been set at \$250.00 Can..

2.3 Launch and Haul out fees will be \$100 Can. and shall be arranged with Loyalist Cove Marina.

2.4 A minimum of 5 boats registered will be required to constitute a regatta.

3. Berthing.

3.1 Loyalist Cove Marina will provide berthing, rafting may be required.

3.2 There will be no hall out or re-launch of a boat after the commencement of the regatta without the consent of the principal race officer or measurer.

4. Race Course.

4.1The racing area will be on the waters of Lake Ontario directly south of Loyalist Cove Marina for course racing. A distance race will be run and may utilize local aids to navigation and or Islands in the area.

4.2 Course diagrams will be included in the Sailing Instructions. Sailing Instructions will be available on registration. The Race Committee will determine course length as sailing conditions permit.

4.3 A distance race of 20-35 miles will be run on either the Friday or Saturday

5. Measurement.

5.1 There will be Sail Measurement and Boat Inspection on Thursday September 11, from 1 pm to 8pm.

5.2 Crew weigh in at commencement of regatta will be done.

6. Social.

Loyalist Cove will have an event tent on site.

Barbecues will be available. The fleet will be holding a pot luck social on Saturday after racing. Awards ceremony will be in the tent at conclusion of racing on Sunday.

7. COMMUNICATIONS

The RC may communicate with the fleet by VHF Radio.

8. PENALTY SYSTEMS

The penalties as per the RRS. Rule 44.1 may be changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required for an infringement of a rule of part 2.

9. SCORING

9.1 Low point system as per appendix A.

9.2 The number of races required to constitute a series is one.

9.3 The number of drop races shall be 1 after 5 races sailed.

9.4 Maximum number of races – Olson 30 – 8 + LD (Fri 1/5, Sat 1/5, Su 3 Max.) no start after 14:30 on Sunday.
