Rules: The regatta will be governed by Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, as modified by Appendix E, this Notice of Race (NOR), The Sailing Instructions (SI), the USA NCA One Metre Class, HMS 2016 and The Equipment Rules of Sailing. The Sailing Instructions (SI) shall prevail in case of conflict with this NOR.
2. Eligibility: The regatta is open to all boats that have a current Certification & recorded with the IOM class. The skipper must be a member of either the A.M.Y.A. or other national governing body and have a valid IOM measurement certificate.

3. Schedule:

Friday, 11/6/2020

11:30am: Registration & Measurement check-in located at BYC.

Only after a Competitor & Boat have completed Measurement & Check-in, may they enjoy practice sailing until 5:15pm The Course will be closed to IOM Sailing from 12:00 noon until 1:00pm each day.

4. Course Location:
Off BYC waterfront docks. Boston Yacht Club, 1 Front Street, Marblehead, MA 01945

5. Measurement: Will be conducted at BYC Yardarm Building. Weigh-in and measurement will be conducted at check-in on Friday, 11/6/2020 from 11:30am - 4:00pm. No boat shall be eligible for racing until it has been registered and measured for the event. Weight spot checks may be conducted on site through the Regatta or as result of a protest or at the discretion of the PRO.

6. Entry: Please Enter Online by going to: <https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=11732> or, by completing the attached Entry Form and submitting it prior to November 01, 2020. Entry fee: \$75.00, guest lunches \$10 per day. Skipper fee includes daily lunch (2 days) from BYC Water & Sodas Available at Dock side Saturday & Sunday, Rum and Awards. Cash bar available at BYC.

7. Race Format: Racing will be conducted under HMS 2016, promotion-relegation. To start the regatta, skippers will be placed in either the A, B, C or D fleet for the seeding race based on a blind draw. The number of boats to be promoted/relegated will be 4 Down / 4 Up. A single fleet may be used for less than 18 competitors. Courses will be set based on the prevailing conditions and announced prior to the start of each race. The sailing instructions will be provided at check-in at the regatta.

8. Scoring: The regatta will be scored in accordance with HMS 2016 Scoring system. Prizes: Minimum of three (3) trophies plus AMYA Chevrons (Red).

9. Disclaimer: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authorities, including IOM NCA, AMYA, US Sailing, the Town of Marblehead & its associated entities, Boston Yacht Club & Winter Island Model Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
