Handicap Ratings and Restrictions: Boats must have a valid PHRF-LE certificate. Single handed sailing is prohibited.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of sailing 2017-2020, the current PHRF-LE code of regulations, this Notice of Race (NoR) and the Sailing Instructions (SIs). In the event of a conflict between the NoR and SIs, the SIs will override the NoR.
