**Support the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society's mission to cure leukemia, lymphoma, Hodgkins and myeloma and improve the quality of life for patients and their families by registering to sail and joining your crew , family and friends in raising funds to accelerate cures**

#### **1) Rules**

1.1 The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020* and the Sailing Instructions provided [online](#) and at the Skippers Meeting

#### **2) Other requirements and notices**

2.1 The crane schedule for launching from OCYC is listed below

- Friday July 10th from 3:00 PM until 7:00 PM
- Saturday July 11th 8:00 AM until 10:00 AM

2.2 For all travelling boats more than 24', slips are reserved at Seaview Harbor Marina. You will need to call before June 15 in order to give a deposit and reserve a slip

2.3 All boats shall carry a VHF radio tuned to their respective channel.

2.4 Advertising shall be restricted to Category A.

#### **3) Fees**

3.1 All boats \$50.00

3.2 Fees Include racing, sailing awards, skippers meeting and skippers bag

#### **4) Eligibility**

4.1 PHRF Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker Fleets

4.2 One-design fleets of 3 or more boats that register before **July 4, 2020**

4.4 Valid 2020 PHRF MA certificate required for all PHRF boats

## 5) Schedule of Events

### 5.1 Registration

5.1.1 Entries must be registered and paid in full before **July 4th, 2020**

5.1.2 Entries received after **July 4th** will be considered on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

5.1.54 All boats must check in at RC Boat before the start of the first race.

9.1 One (1) race completed is required to constitute the series. The Low Point System, RRS Appendix A, will apply

## **12) Prizes**

12.1 Prizes for first, second, and possibly third for overall winners of each division depending on the number of boats registered in the division.

12.2 Awards will be given for first, second and third place boats for fundraising.

## **13) Disclaimer of Liability**

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. (See RRS 4, DECISION TO RACE). The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. All boats must sign a liability waiver to downloaded from the website

13.2 The safety of a boat and its crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the Skipper who shall ensure that the boat is fully sound, thoroughly seaworthy, and manned by an experienced and physically able crew. Neither the establishment of regulations or inspection of a boat in any way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibility of the Skipper.

13.3 The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society, Ocean City Yacht Club , Yacht Club of Stone Harbor, Corinthian Yacht Club Cape May and their employees and volunteers do not accept responsibility for the loss of life or injury to participants or others, or for the loss or damage to any vessel in any way or from any cause during or relating to this event.

13.4 The Skipper shall be responsible for the conduct of his crew. In the event of a serious breach of conduct, the destruction of property or the failure to comply with a reasonable request of any Race Officer or Committee Member, the Skipper will be responsible for all damages and the boat may be subject to protest, which may include disqualification from the regatta.

## **14) Insurance**

Each boat shall hold a minimum of \$300,000 including third-party liability insurance, and it is the owner or owner's' representative's sole and inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate prior to participating in this event.
