EVENT SAFETY & COVID-19

- Self symptom check before leaving home—please do not come to the event if you have any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Please do not travel to the event from any of the Public Health England Local Authority Watch List Intervention Areas listed in the latest [“Weekly Coronavirus Disease 2019 \(Covid-19\) Surveillance Report”](#).

- Limit car sharing.
- Register your attendance with the host club for test and trace by completing the Crew List section on Yachtscoring with all crew names and contact information .
- Arrive in sailing kit where possible.
- Sanitise hands on arrival and prior to touching any shared surface.
- Maintain social distancing at all times whilst ashore before launching and after recovery.
- Please ensure that 1 metre + social distancing is maintained at all times when launching, berthing and hauling out boats. Separate berthing areas will be provided for small groups of up to four sports boats and dayboats. Please control arrival and departure times, crew numbers aboard and crew positioning to maintain social distancing . Please wear face masks where appropriate while launching, berthing and hauling out boats.

Please read the RYA [“Guidance on sailing and racing with participants from different households during Covid - 19 in England”](#). This is essential for your safety and for the safety of everyone involved in this event.

Please note that you must be a member of the SB20 Class in order to compete in the event.

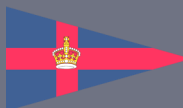
CLUBHOUSE FOOD & DRINK
