**1. Rules**

1.1 The Pass-A-Grille Run Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*

**2. Eligibility & Entry**

2.1 Open to boats with a current valid WFPHRF rating certificate meeting the requirements of a WFPHRF Category 4 regatta.

2.2 Anticipated classes are Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, Racer/Cruiser, Cruiser and Multihull

2.3 Eligible boats may enter by registering at Yachtscoring.com.

2.4 No entries will be accepted after 1700 hrs. on Thursday, March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

2.5 Skippers in Cruising Classes must declare their intent to use a cruising spinnaker no later than Thursday, March 5<sup>th</sup> 1700 hrs. Notice is completed with a email to Race Committee at [dckoffsu@gmail.com](mailto:dckoffsu@gmail.com) with confirmation back to the sender.

2.6 Skipper must acknowledge liability waiver at registration and note their insurance carrier on their boat at the online registration site.

**3. Fees & Registration**

3.1 The entry fee is \$35 if received by 2400 hrs. on Monday, March 2 and \$45.00 if received by 1700 hrs. on March 5<sup>th</sup>. Payment can be made with a credit card at your registration on YachtScoring.com

**4. Schedule of Events**

<u>Friday</u>	March 6	1800 hrs. - Registration at Dunedin Boat Club 49 Edgewater Dr., Dunedin 1830 hrs. - Skippers Meeting
<u>Saturday</u>	March 7	0855 First Warning (No starts after 1200) Awards as soon as possible after the finish, prizes awarded at Pass a Grille YC.
<u>Sunday</u>	March 8 (reserved)	0855 First warning <b><u>if race postponed due to adverse weather</u></b>

**5. Sailing Instructions**

5.1 The Sailing Instructions shall be available at the Skippers Meeting and may be posted at [www.yachtscoring.com](http://www.yachtscoring.com).

**6. Venue**

6.1 **This is a point-to-point race with a pursuit start.** The racing area is the Gulf of Mexico between Clearwater Pass and Pass a Grille Channel.

**7. Course**

7.1 The course will be illustrated in the Sailing Instructions.

### 8. Scoring

- 8.1 A minimum of one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 8.2 Appendix A is modified so that no races are excluded
- 8.3 The WFPHRF RLC rating using time on distance will be used for all classes.

### 9. Berthing

- 9.1 Slips/rafting is available at St. Petersburg Yacht Club at Pass a Grille on a first come/first served basis. See the Pass-a-Grill **Facility Protocol document** at [Yachtscoring.com](http://Yachtscoring.com) registration.

### 10. Radio Communication

- 10.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all competitors.

### 11. Prizes

- 11.1 Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third place in each class.

### 12. Disclaimer of Liability

- 12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. **See RRS 4, Decision to Race.** The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta. Skippers are required to review and accept their waiver acknowledgement in their on-line registration.
