



Notice of Race – Big Tom City Island Cup

HARLEM YACHT CLUB
JUNE 13 & 14, 2020

EVENT

1.0 The City Island Cup consists of up to five scheduled races in and around Eastchester Bay.

1.1 The organizing authority is the Harlem Yacht Club.

SCHEDULE AND LOCATION

2.0 The races take place June 13th & 14th. The starting Area will be in Eastchester Bay, in the vicinity of 46A.

2.1 The first warning gun will be no earlier than 1200 each day.

ELIGIBILITY

3.0 The series is open to PHRF spinnaker and non-spinnaker yachts with a valid YRALIS PHRF Rating or One-design yachts in their own division with 4 or more entries.

3.1 All yachts are required to have a working VHF radio capable of receiving VHF channel 71.

RULES

4.0 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

DIVISIONS

5.0 PHRF and One-Design or level divisions shall be determined after all entries are received.

REGISTRATION AND FEES

6.0 Registration is available on Yachtscoring.com.

6.1 The entry fee is \$100. Early entry fee will be \$80 before May 25

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.0 Sailing instructions will be available on yachtscoring.com.

COURSES

8.0 Courses will be using government and dropped marks, signaled from the committee boat and outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

SCORING

9.0 Races will be scored using the Low Point System as in RRS Appendix A.

9.1 If 5 races are completed a yacht's worst score will be excluded.

9.2 PHRF divisions will be scored using time-on-time based on a time correction factor (TCF) derived using the formula $TCF = 600/(480+PHRF)$.

AMENDMENTS

10.0 Any additions or changes to the sailing instructions or scratch sheet will be posted on the yachtscoring website by 0900 on the day they take effect. Notices of changes will be emailed to all competitors.

AWARDS

11.0 Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers in each division.

11.1 Overall trophies for the best performance, as determined by the race committee in both Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker Fleets

The Race committee will communicate with racing yachts on VHF channel 71.

SOCIAL INFORMATION

Competitors and crew are invited to after race festivities at the club which will on Saturday include entertainment from the Harlem House Band.
