

NOTICE OF RACE

September 25-27, 2020

1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), the prescriptions of US SAILING, except as these are changed by this Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions.

2. ALTERATION OF RULES

- 2.1. The following racing rules will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.
 - (a) Rules 35, A4.2, A5 and Al 1 will be changed so that boats failing to finish within fifteen minutes after the first boat in its class finishes will be scored points equal to the last finisher plus two.
 - (b) Rule 62.l(a) will be changed to limit the grounds for a request for redress concerning courtesy broadcasts.
 - (c) Rule 62.2 and 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and for requesting reopening of a hearing on the last day of racing.
 - (d) Rule A2 will be changed so that a boat's total score will be the sum of the scores for all races, and no score will be excluded.
 - (e) RRS 40 will be changed so that all competitors must wear personal flotation devices at all times if required by the race committee.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. Entry will be by invitation only.
- 3.2. Procedure for invitation, teams within the Midwest Collegiate Sailing Association (MCSA):
 - 3.2.1. Teams will sign-up for the regatta in accordance to MCSA procedures (e.g. at MCSA Midwinters Meeting via the draft process).
 - 3.2.2. Invitations will be sent by the OA to the initial twelve (12) MCSA teams in "draft order" by 07/10/20 and on a rolling basis-thereafter.
 - 3.2.3. Teams must accept invites within 30 days, or their spot will be forfeited.
- 3.3. Procedure for invitation, teams not within the Midwest Collegiate Sailing Association (MCSA):
 - 3.3.1. Teams will request an invitation via the "request for invitation" form.
 - 3.3.2. This form will be made available no later than 05/01/20 via the ICSA List Serve, teams may also visit http://www.chicagot10.com/glior after 05/01/20 for a live link.

- 3.3.3. Invitations will be sent by the OA to non-MCSA by 07/17/20 and on a rolling basis there-after.
- 3.4. Teams will register on a rolling basis until 08/31/20, there will be no registrations after 08/31/20.
- 3.5. A minimum of four and maximum of six crew members are required to compete.
 - 3.5.1. All crew members must be students enrolled in the college which they are representing.

4. FEES

4.1. There will be a \$100.00 registration fee for this regatta, this is per team.

5. THE BOAT

5.1. The Tartan 10 and J105 Fleet will be supplying boats for this regatta. Teams will receive boat assignments no later than one-week prior to the regatta start date. There will be two fleets.

6.2. It is the intent of the Race Committee to complete as many races as practical each day.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the regatta start date.
- 7.2 In case of a conflict between the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail. This changes RRS 63.7.

8. RACING AREA

8.1 The racing area will be offshore due East of Montrose Harbor entrance. The exact location and courses will be in the Sailing Instructions.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 Each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.
- 9.2 One race will constitute a regatta.
- 9.3 Scoring software will be used, teams will have access to scoring online as is practical.
- 9.4 Teams are required to be registered via the online scoring system.

10. PRIZES

10.1 The top three finishing teams will receive awards

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this regatta to the fullest extent permitted by law.

12. INSURANCE

12.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per regatta or the equivalent.

13. HOUSING

13.1. Teams will be able to sleep aboard their assigned boats and should bring personal bedding items. However, teams are encouraged to arrange separate local housing accommodations.

14. FOOD

- 14.1. The OA will provide lunches free-of-charge Saturday and Sunday for all sailors on board.
- 14.2. The Galley at the Chicago Corinthian Yacht Club will provide an a-la-carte menu for all other menus, at the participants expense.
