NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Shelter Island Yacht Club.

GENERAL FORMAT

- SIYC Race Week at Shelter Island will consist of several days of racing including dinghy, one-design and handicap racing.
- There will be two separate events for yachts racing in IRC, PHRF and eligible One- Design classes:
 - The Around-the-Island Race on Friday, July 31.
 - The Anniversary Regatta, a one-day series of shorter races on Saturday, August 1.
- A separate NOR for the Around the Island Race on Friday, July 31 is available on Yacht Scoring.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, the 2020 IRC Rules Parts A, B and C, and the ELIYA General Conditions.
- 1.2 **RRS 52** is modified to allow power operated winches for yachts sailing in non-spinnaker classes.

2 CHANGES TO THE NOTICE OF RACE

Any amendments to the Notice of Race will be posted on the Yacht Scoring website.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Entry is open to yachts that satisfy one or more of the entry requirements in NOR 3.2 to 3.5 or to a class invited by the OA.
- 3.2 **IRC Yachts:** Entry is open to all yachts with a valid 2020 IRC certificate.
- 3.3 **PHRF Yachts:** Entry is open to all yachts with a valid 2020 PHRF of Eastern Long Island certificate. Temporary PHRF of Eastern Long Island rating certificates can be obtained for the event.
- 3.4 **One-Design Yachts:** Entry is open to all classes with a minimum of three entries unless otherwise approved by the OA, and to any classes invited by the OA.
- 3.5 Yachts entered in IRC and one design classes are expected to comply with their class rules.
- 3.6 Depending on the number of entries, PHRF, IRC and one design yachts might be combined with other divisions. In this case, entries will be scored for all divisions for which they qualify.
- 3.7 **Entry Forms:** Entry Forms are available on Yacht Scoring, www.yachtscoring.com. The official entry form and entry fee shall be submitted using Yacht Scoring. Complete applications, including valid rating certificates will be due by 1800 on Thursday, July 30, 2020.

4 FEES

Entry fees:

Under 30 feet	\$100

6 MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 Each yacht shall submit a valid rating certificate to the SIYC Sailing Center by 1800 on Thursdays, July 30. Certificates shall be e-mailed to: rc@siyc.com.
- (a) One-design yachts shall submit either a copy of their valid class measurement certificate when one is required by their class rules or a valid 2020 PHRF certificate indicating an ODR rating.
 - (b) PHRF yachts shall submit a copy of their valid 2020 PHRF of Eastern Long Island certificate. Temporary PHRF of Eastern Long Island rating certificates will be issued to competing yachts based on submission of a valid certificate from another organization or completion of a PHRF of Eastern Long Island PHRF rating form.
 - (c) IRC yachts shall submit a copy of their valid 2020 IRC certificate.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND CLASS ASSIGNMENTS

Sailing Instructions and scratch sheets will be available on Yacht Scoring.

8 VENUE

Races will be held on the waters around Shelter Island, including Orient Harbor, Gardiners Bay, Noyac Bay and Peconic Bay.

9 COURSES

Courses for all classes will be defined in the sailing instructions.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 Rule 44.1 is changed to incorporate Rule V1.
- 10.2 Rule 44.3 is replaced by Rule V2.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 The **Anniversary Regatta** on Saturday, August 1, shall be scored as a separate event.
- 11.2 IRC classes will be scored using the IRC Time Corrector (TCC) using time-on-time scoring.
- 11.3 PHRF classes will be scored using time-on-time scoring. TCFs will be calculated using the formula specified in the SIs.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The Race Committee VHF Channel(s) will be indicated in the SIs. Boats shall carry an operating VHF radio capable of receiving weather bulletins and communications from the Race Committee as well as communicating any emergency on board.

13 MOORINGS

- 13.1 Complimentary day moorings will be available for competitors during the party.
- 13.2 Complimentary overnight moorings may be provided subject to availability.

14 PRIZES

Trophies for the Anniversary Regatta will be presented at the Competitor’s Party after the racing on Saturday, August 1 at The Shelter Island Yacht Club. Prizes will be awarded to the top yachts in each class.

15 LIABILITY & MEDIA WAIVER

15.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Attention is also drawn to RRS 46 and USSER 1.2, Responsibility.

15.2 Media Waiver - Competitors and crew members on the competing yachts grant, at no cost, the Shelter Island Yacht Club, and any other official sponsors of the regatta, the absolute right and permission to use their name, voice, image, likeness, biographical material as well as representations of the boats in any media worldwide (being television, print and internet media), including video footage, for the sole purposes of advertising, promoting, reporting and disseminating information regarding Race Week at Shelter Island and the participants in the Race Week at Shelter Island.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be adequately insured with valid third-party liability insurance that is appropriate taking into account the value of the boats racing and the type of racing.
