### NOTICE OF RACE

Rules The Regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to PHRF and various one-design classes. PHRF competitors must have a valid

2014 PHRF-MA certificate; one-design competitors must produce a valid 2014 class measurement certificate and be a 2014 class association member. The Junior Regatta does not require previous sentence. A minimum of 5 boats is required for a one-design start. Class and PHRF division splits will be posted prior to 0930 hours on September 19, 2014 on the official notice board on the club deck. Class/Division pennants must be flown. Eligibility for Commodore's Cup is for vessels with PHRF- MA rating of 120 or higher or the helmsperson has not won a race at RYC in the last 10 years. Eligibility for Junior Regatta is the skipper or crew must be members of RYC Junior Organization or Perth Amboy High School Sailing Team or invited guests of RYC Junior Organization or

participants in RYC Junior Sailing Class in 2014.

ENTRIES

Eligible boats may enter by completing the official entry process on the Yacht Scoring

web site http://www.yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=1203 and paying all fees,

through September 20.

ENTRY FEE If received by September 20, the entry fees are \$125 plus a bag of non-perishable

groceries to donate to the Perth Amboy food pantry (We Care). Alternate to a bag of groceries, a \$25 donation payable to We Care can be provided. Entry fee for Saturdays Commodore Cup Race is \$50 plus grocery bag or \$25 donation to We Care. Entry fees include sailing, launching. Entry fee for Junior Regatta is \$25 per competitor plus food

donation.

Sailing Instructions will be available prior 0830 hrs on September 21 at the regatta desk.

SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply. One race will constitute a

regatta.

SCHEDULE

Harbor start will be at 1100 hrs. The first warning signal is scheduled for 1200 hrs each

day. The number of races will be determined by the race committee. No warning signal

will be made after 1500 hrs on Sunday.

RACE AREA Races will be sailed in Raritan Bay. The approximate starting area will be east of Great

Beds Light and West of the area between Keyport "1" and Sequine Point, Staten Island, NYexcept for Commodore's Cup and Junior Regatta. The general area for Commdore's Cup will be in the area of General Anchorages 44 and 45. The Junior Regatta will be in the area of the Perth Amboy High School Sailing Team fleet located on the beach near

Second Street and the train bridge.

COURSES Courses will be windward/leeward, or as described in the Sailing Instructions.

PRIZES

Awards will be given for the top three finishers in each class following racing on Sunday.

LOGISTICS

The Club's hoist will be available for launching and hauling. A limited number of free guest moorings are available. For mooring reservations contact <u>alan.uminski@verizon.net</u> or text 908-268-5355.
