Addendum I: to original Notice of Race from 2/18/2020

- 1a: Registration and Full payment is due by July 6th for **PHRF, JAM, & Cruising Class** entries. This is necessary in order for the committee to reserve dockage and cover static costs of holding the regatta. It would be very much appreciated if all entries could observe this deadline. Thereafter sec 2.8 shall still apply.
- 1b: Registration for the **Hobie Wave Nationals** will remain open until July 24th per 2.7 of NOR Per sec. 2.8, after July 24 the \$35 late fee shall be applied.
- 1c: **Portsmouth** class entries will be accepted until July 17th. Thereafter 2.8 shall be applied.
- 2: All PHRF, JAM, & Cruising Class races will be around the islands courses. Cruising Class will do one race per day while PHRF & JAM classes will do one or more races as weather and wind conditions permit. Number of starts and divisions will be determined by the number of entries. This changes sec. 8.1.
- 3: Portsmouth Center Board Dinghy Class Division will be a combination of all center board dinghies with Portsmouth ratings. If a class has at least 5 entries, they may receive their own start and scoring.
- 4: Since Senior Bayweek has no age limitations, All Junior racers are invited to attend Senior Bayweek and compete in the Portsmouth Class. You may sail with another family member or teammate (s) of your choice. Teammates may be an adult or another junior.
- 5: Additional trophies may be awarded in PHRF, JAM, & Cruising class for scoring an entry as a "Family" or "Doublehanded". Double handed entries will be given a separate start for safety if enough entries declare for this class prior to the start of the regatta. This is in addition to sec. 11.5
- 6: Entry fees will be refunded if the regatta cannot be held for any reason beyond the Organizing Authorities control.
