5. **SCHEDULE**
  - 5.2.1. The Practice Race, scheduled for 20 May 2020, will not occur for the 2020 season.
  
15. **PROTESTS, REQUESTS FOR REDRESS, AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION**
  - 15.1. Protest forms are available at <https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=12929> under General Race Forms. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered to a race officer in the Club office or sent electronically to [BristolYCRace@gmail.com](mailto:BristolYCRace@gmail.com)
  - 15.2. Protests must be submitted within 3 days of race completion.
  - 15.3. Notices will be posted after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held via video teleconference or in a location where social distancing can be accomplished, at a time and place mutually agreed by the parties to the protest and the Protest Committee.
  - 15.5. If the race committee posts a list of boats scored OCS, ZFP or BFD on the official notice board before the protest time limit, a request for redress based on such a posted score shall be made not later than 3 days after posting. This changes rule 62.2.
