

NOTICE OF RACE

Lake Champlain Leukemia Cup Regatta
Burlington Harbor Marina, Burlington, VT
**Saturday, August 29, 2020 (postponed from June
27, 2020)**

SCHEDULE:

- Skippers Meeting at Burlington Harbor Marina 9:00 a.m.
- First Gun 11:00 a.m.
- Awards & Party at Burlington Harbor Marina 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

RACE FORMAT & LOCATION: Racing will be held on Lake Champlain. The start/finish line shall be between the race committee signal boat and the Lake Champlain Yacht Club "B" mark, outside the Burlington Breakwater. The race shall be a pursuit race. Specific course details will be outlined in the Sailing Instructions. This race shall be a part of the Lake Champlain Championship Series.

CLASSES: There shall be a spinnaker and jib and main class. There shall be individual fleets scored in accordance with the Lake Champlain Championship series.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all boats registered to race on Lake Champlain with an assigned PHRF rating.

EQUIPMENT & CLASS RULES: The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 shall apply.

SCORING: Scoring will be based on PHRF time on distance. PHRF handicaps will be assigned by the Lake Champlain Leukemia Cup Regatta Committee and are not a basis for protest. Handicaps will include allowances for racing experience, racing condition of the boat, racing condition of the sails, and special allowance for non-spinnaker competitors.

REGISTRATION: Pre-registration is required via online registration at www.leukemicup.org/lakechamplain Early bird registration deadline for \$150 is Friday, July 15. Late registration deadline for \$175 is August 25, 2020 at 5:00 pm.

ENTRY FEES: The entry fee is \$150 per boat until July 15, 2020. After July 15, 2020, registration fee is \$175. Entry fee includes four post-race party tickets. Extra post-race party tickets are \$25 per person advance sale (\$20 under 21), \$30 at the door.

PARTY: Party tickets are available through www.leukemicup.org/lakechamplain (\$20 under 21); \$30 at the door. Open to the public - please invite your friends and family. Party tickets include Gosling's Rum, wine and beer, food, and music on Saturday night, August 29 under the tent at Burlington Harbor Marina.
