CRYC Covid-19 Rules for Regattas



- a. Only sailors that are CRYC members are permitted to use club facilities and amenities, with the exceptions listed below.
- b. The non-member crews for CRYC members are allowed to go straight to the boat from off the club premises.
- c. No onsite parking for non-members.
- d. Upon arrival the CRYC members' crews will be temperature tested at the Security Gate
- e. CRYC member non-member crews may use the boathouse ONLY for showering, restroom.
- f. No guest cards, nor reciprocal billing
- g. Non-member teams may not sail from CRYC. The US SAILING Center or another venue on Biscayne Bay can be alternatives.
- h. Non-members are otherwise not currently permitted on the premises. Sailors should not venture between BBYC and the USSC through CRYC.
- i. Sailors meet on the water.
- j. No competitor's meetings or awards ceremonies at CRYC.
- k. Under the current City of Miami guidelines, social distancing will be followed. All crew rigging must comply accordingly and boats will be placed to facilitate distancing.
- I. Keep Dry Slip area clear, do not block passages.
- m. CRYC has a very active member youth program, all sailors will take direction from the Dockmaster, Waterfront Director or youth sailing coaches to not compromise social distancing and mask ordnances.
- n. Stay at home if you have any of the following symptoms, a cold, runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, cough, or fever.
- o. Launch and retrieval times for CRYC member teams at CRYC will be allocated by the Dockmaster
- Sailors must always wear face covering masks (not just gaiters) while on CRYC property
- q. The CRYC will consider disciplinary action to any sailor who violates the guidelines set forth, up to and including excusal from the Regatta and Club Property.
