NOTICE OF RACE

1. Invitation

All PHRF cruising and racing boats are invited to participate in the 2020 Commonwealth Cup Regatta.

The Commonwealth Cup is a distance race sailed on Saturday, October 3rd.

The Commonwealth Cup One-Design is a windward-leeward round-the-buoys race for one design fleets with three or more registered boats. It is sailed on both Saturday, October 3rd and Sunday, October 4th.

The Colonel's Revenge Race is a pursuit style race open to all PHRF cruising and racing boats and is sailed on Sunday, October 4th.

2. Rules

All Regatta races will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

3. Eligibility and Entry

All boats must complete a PHRF measurement form in order to participate. Forms may be completed on-line utilizing yachtscoring.com. Forms will also be available at the Captain's Meeting on Friday evening. All boats must be registered by 1900, Friday, October 2, 2020.

4. Fees

Registration fee for all boats entering the Regatta is \$70.

5. Classes

Eligible classes for the Commonwealth Cup include JAM A, JAM B, SPINNAKER and CRUISING CLASS.

The Commonwealth Cup One-Design is open to one-design classes with three or more registered boats. We expect that there will be a J-22 Class.

6. Event Schedule:

Friday, October 2, 2020

1700 Commonwealth Cup registration and Captain's meeting at the Thirsty Turtle Tavern at Green Turtle Bay Resort & Marina.

Saturday, October 3, 2020

0900 Commonwealth Cup distance race begins on Kentucky Lake followed by the start of the One-Design series.

1800 Dinner and awards ceremony under the tent at the Thirsty Turtle Tavern.

Sunday, October 4, 2020

0900 Colonel's Revenge Round-the Buoys Fun Race begins on Kentucky Lake followed by the start of the One-Design series.

7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at the event's registration and Captain's Meetings.

8. Scoring

Scoring will be per the Racing Rules of Sailing and will take place on yachtscoring.com

9. Prizes

Trophies and prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers in each class. The Commonwealth Cup trophy will be awarded to the overall winner based on corrected time.

The entire membership of the Commonwealth Yacht Club invites you to attend and participate in this 15th Annual Commonwealth Regatta. We have moved the registration, meetings and evening festivities to The Thirsty Turtle Tavern this year to take advantage of its outdoor facilities where appropriate social distancing can be observed and enjoy live entertainment for all participants and attendees.
