# 2020 Social Distance Race <br> Sailing Instructions <br> May 30, 2020 

## 1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

## 2 SCHEDULE OF RACES

2.1 Racing is scheduled as follows: Saturday May 30th 11:55 First warning

3 DIVISIONS There will be one division

4 Eligible Crew
3.1 Crew is limited to the first "stay at home" order unless otherwise noted. This means that your crew must be those that you sheltered in place with. On your honor.
3.2 If you have been sheltering in place by yourself and you want to participate, you may add 1 crew member as long as you are able to apply to the current "stay at home order" which means 6' separation and masks. This option only cost's you $15 \mathrm{sec} /$ mile on your rating. Adjust your rating when registering. On your honor

5 THE COURSES There will be three course options signaled by flag on shore.

Red Flag- 4 mile course- After start proceed to an orange inflatable 2 miles upriver. The mark will be about 100 yards off the freighter channel on the American Side. Round the mark to Starboard and proceed to the finish.

Green Flag- 6 mile course- After start proceed to an orange inflatable 3 miles upriver. The mark will be about 100 yards off the freighter channel on the American Side. Round the mark to Starboard and proceed to the finish.

Yellow Flag- 8 mile course- After start proceed to an orange inflatable 4 miles upriver. The mark will be about 100 yards off the freighter channel on the American Side. Round the mark to Starboard and proceed to the finish.

There are no provisions for shortening any course

## THE START

61 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on shore at BYC Point and an orange inflatable.
6.2 Race is a pursuit race and start times are as follows:
6.3 Start Signals. Race committee will give countdown over VHF to the following times for watch synchronizing: $11: 45,11: 50,11: 55$. After that, they will sound a horn at each boats designated start time. There will be no visual signals. Boats that are OCS will be hailed 1 time via VHF.
7. THE FINISH The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on shore at BYC Point and an orange inflatable. Finish will be in opposite direction of start.
8. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS There will be NO PROTESTS. 720's may be done to exonerate a foul.
9. SCORING First boat across the finish line wins.
10. SAFETY all competitors are required to maintain proper social distancing. A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible.
11. PRIZES There will be awards for $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ place. Awards will be presented shortly after last boat docks.
