The Social Distance Race will be held Saturday May 30th. First gun is at noon. Here are some of the details:

- Unless State guidelines change between now and May 30th, this event is not promoting any post-race social activities. This is strictly a sailboat race.
- The race is not a Club Sponsored event
- Race will be a Pursuit Race
- Course will be set around Government Buoy's
- Scoring will be based on PHRF handicapping
- If you do not have a PHRF handicap you can be assigned one. Request's must be made by May 23rd
- Crew is limited to the first "stay at home" order unless otherwise noted. This means that your crew must be those that you sheltered in place with. On your honor
- Event is open to BYC boats only with the exception of any Cal 25's that cares to join. (Sorry... my event, my rules)
- You may take a 3 sec credit on your PHRF Rating if you make a \$50 or more contribution to a Covid-19 type charity or donate blood between now and registering. Adjust your rating when registering. On your honor
- If you have been sheltering in place by yourself and you want to participate, you may add 1 crew member as long as you are able to apply to the current "stay at home order" which means 6' separation and masks. This option only cost's you 15 sec/ mile on your rating. Adjust your rating when registering. On your honor
- No limit on sails used
- All boats must be registered by 6pm May 27th to allow time to calculate start times for each boat.
- Course options and associated start times will be posted by 6pm Friday May 29th.
