Amendments in *italics* 

### **3 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS**

Is amended as follows:

3.3 The race committee intends to monitor and communicate with competitors **as follows:** *Friday:* 

GL52 Course: VHF channel 79 OD Course: VHF channel 74 Saturday and Sunday: Tour Courses VHF channel 79 OD Course: VHF channel 74

### 5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Is amended as follows:

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole at the Little Traverse Yacht Club and broadcast on *VHF* 74 and 79.
- 5.2 At 1030 hours each day the Race Committee will signal with one sound and announce on **VHF 74 and 79**, a Harbor Start for all Classes. Postponement or abandonment for some classes may be signaled instead of the Harbor Start. If the AP (postponement) Flag is displayed ashore, the first warning signal will not be made less than 60 minutes after the AP Flag is lowered. This modifies rule Race Signals.

### 7 RACING AREAS

Is amended as follows:

- 7.2 Friday: GL52 Class rendezvous point will be LTYC fixed mark "W" OD Classes rendezvous point will be LTYC fixed mark "I"
- 7.3 For Saturday and Sunday's "Tour of the Bay" racing, the rendezvous point for all boats will be at fixed mark "G," "I" or "W," to be announced at the Harbor Start on VHF 79. **OD Classes rendezvous point will be at fixed mark "F".**

#### 8 THE COURSES

Is amended as follows:

8.1 Friday courses will be windward/leeward 4 legs. Windward/leeward courses will be sailed with marks left to port. An offset mark may be set at the windward mark. If no offset is in place, boats shall round the single windward mark. A leeward mark will be set to windward of the starting line. The leeward mark may be a gate. If no gate is in place, the single leeward mark should be rounded to port.

#### 11 THE START

Is amended as follows:

11.1 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on a race committee boat or the course side of a robotic or inflatable mark at the port end and a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee signal boat at the starboard end. *For the GL52 class only:* 

The race committee may use a LTYC fixed mark or a robotic mark as the starboard end and will not be using signal flags. This changes rule 26. There will be a race committee signal boat stationed outside the starboard end of the starting line to call any boats OCS. Boats shall not pass between the starboard end of the line and the race committee boat.

13 THE FINISH

Is amended as follows:

13.1 **Friday:** 

GL52 class: The finish line will be between a LTYC fixed mark, or a robotic mark and a nearby robotic or inflatable mark. There will be a race committee signal boat stationed outside the port end of the finish line taking finish times. Boats shall not pass between the port end of the line and the race committee boat.

OD classes: The finish line will be the starting line.
