

## **MCYC Tri-State race from St. Joe to Michigan City Sailing Instructions, Amendment 1.**

**Amendment 1, supersedes relevant statements in initial Sis.**

### **7. MEASUREMENT**

7.1. All boats competing in these Races must have a valid 2020 LMPHRF certificate, and race in full compliance with that certificate. All Races will be scored using each boat's LMPHRF general purpose rating.

### **10. THE COURSE**

219°T

#### **Start:**

The start will be between the St. Joe SW Mark and the St. Joe pierhead. All boats must start within 100 yards of the ST Joe SW Mark. The location of the St. Joe SW Mark is 42° 07.066 N & 086° 31.475 W. The location of the St. Joe pierhead is 42° 07.01 N & 086° 29.81 W. No committee boat will be present for the start.

There will be one start sequence. All sections will start together. Five minute sequence starts at 9:30 am CDT (CENTRAL Daylight Time).

#### **Finish:**

The finish will be between SJMC-5 and an inflatable mark off a RC boat. The location of SJMC-5 is 41° 44 640 N & 086° 53 950 W.

Sail Number Boards shall be displayed on the yacht's starboard side. Yacht Finish Reports are required and must be turned in within one hour of your finish at RC headquarters in the Clubhouse.

### **ALTERNATE FINISHING**

For heavy weather, the finish will be between the course side of the MC lighthouse and the east end of the Government pier, gap. Finishing through 'the gap' is allowed but yachts must immediately turn into the channel for necessary depth. It is quite possible that RC cannot stand on the pier head, so finish reports may be the only time of record.

The time limit is 1800 CDT.

HANDICAP SCORING DISTANCE IS 28.0 NM. If the alternate finish is used, the distance will be adjusted to 29 NM.

## **19. SOCIAL ACTIVITIES**

Rum Party in the Clubhouse before dinner. Cash bar. Awards ceremony at 8 PM CDT. Dining will be offered by the "Fish Camp and Oyster Bar Kitchen", (219) 879-9544, in the clubhouse and on the deck. Food service will be available for lunch and dinner on Sunday. Please refrain from bringing food and drink from yachts to the restaurant. Ice and bottled water will also be available for purchase on Sunday until 5 PM CDT at the "Base Camp" restaurant (formerly "Dock Side), near the Port Authority building. The bath house east of the Coast Guard station is available. All other bath houses are for MC Port Authority, slip holders and fee-paying transients only. Call MCPA, (219) 872-1712, to rent a slip.
