Entries: Entries should be created online at www.yachtscoring.com. All entrants and crew must abide by the DIYC COVID-19 Racers Advisory & Protocols with the exception of masks, which are not required to be worn on the water, and must read and sign the DIYC COVID-19 Waiver/Release which will be available in the document section of the YachtScoring event page.

Start: In or near Duck Island Roads, Westbrook, CT. The scheduled First Warning Signal for Series races is 1200.

Rules: These races will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020*, the *DIYC One-Design Sailing Instructions*, this *Notice of Race*, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, and the rules of the Associations of the JY15 Class and Laser Class. A minimum of 5 boats are required for each class in order to have a start.

Rules Changes: The Sailing Instructions change the following rules: *Rule 35* – Time limit is by boat, and *Rule 82* – Indemnification or Hold Harmless Agreements.

Courses: Will be selected immediately prior to each race by the Race Committee and signaled in accordance with the *Sailing Instructions*.

Sailing Instructions: Will be available at least one week before the first Warning Signal of the first race on the Duck Island Yacht Club web site www.diyc.com and on the YachtScoring event page. Notices to Competitors will be posted on the YachtScoring event page and on the Race Committee bulletin board located below the deck in the front of the clubhouse building, Hammock Road South, Westbrook, CT.

Entry Fee: \$25

All boats and trailers are welcome the night before and must be removed by end of day Sunday, September 13, 2020.
