4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE


Signals made a shore will be displayed on the NYC flag pole directly to the west of the clubhouse.


7 RACING AREA

The racing areas will be in Humber bay west of the Toronto Islands.

8 THE COURSES

8.1 is modified to also include the following courses:





9 MARKS

Marks will be as follows:

Start Mark
Windward & Offset Marks
Gate Marks
Finish Mark
Change Mark
Green inflatable
Orange inflatable
Red inflatable
Yellow inflatable

11 THE START

The starting line will be between the Start mark and the staff displaying the orange flag on the R/C boat.

12 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

12.4 is replaced with:

Courses will not be shortened to less than 2 legs in length. The leg to 1a is not considered a leg of the course for this purpose.

13 THE FINISH

The finish line will be between the Finish mark and the staff displaying the orange flag on the R/C boat.

14 TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

14.4 is replaced with: The target time is 50 minutes. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1 (a).

15 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

15.1 is replaced with:

Protest forms are available at the officer of the day station on the first floor of the NYC clubhouse. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered there with in the time limit.

15.6 The protest room location on the first floor of the NYC clubhouse.

ARBITRATION

- 15.7 For a protest between two boats alleging a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31, an arbitration meeting may be held prior to any protest hearing.
- 15.8 One representative from each boat will meet with the arbitrator. No witnesses will be permitted. The Arbitrator may subsequently sit on the Jury hearing the protest.
- 15.9 The arbitrator will advise on whether:
 - a) One or both boats should take a penalty;
 - b) The protest should be withdrawn; or
 - c) The protest should go to the protest committee for a hearing.
- 15.10 When a boat accepts a penalty or the arbitrator advises that the protest should be withdrawn, the arbitrator will allow the protest to be withdrawn. This changes rule 63.1.
- 15.11 When a protest is withdrawn, it will not be reopened or made the subject of a request for redress

22 RADIO COMMUNICATION

22.2 is modified as follows: VHF channel 74

23 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:
