Notice of Race

1 RULES

- 1.1 All races organized by the Buffalo Small Boat Sailing League (the BSBSL) will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), this *Notice of Race* (NOR), and the *Sailing Instructions* (SI).
- 1.2 Prescriptions of 2017-2020 US Sailing except as any of these are modified by the NOR, and by the SI (and any amendments thereto) shall apply to all boats.
- 1.3 RRS 63.7 shall be replaced by: "If there is a conflict between a rule in the Notice of Race and a rule in the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall apply"
- 1.4 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at (https://yachtscoring.com/notice_board.cfm?eid=13207)

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Competitor advertising will comply with World Sailing Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1 All races are open to all boats. A boat is considered registered after both the online registration has been completed and the entry fee has been received by the organizing authority.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at: (https://yachtscoring.com/event_registration_email.cfm?eID=13207)

4 ENTRY FEES

- 4.1 The entry fees for the current registered and paid BSBSL competitors is \$25.
- 4.2 The entry fees for non registered and paid BSBSL competitors is \$35.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration closes October 17, 2020 at 1000.
- 5.2 Competitors briefing will be at 1030 at Sail Buffalo.
- 5.2 The scheduled time for the first warning signal will be 1200.
- 5.3 No warning signal shall be made after 1630.
- 5.4 Dinner & Awards will start as soon as practical after the last race.
- 5.5 As many races as practical will be sailed, no maximum.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

8 INSURANCE

8.1 The organizing authority recommends that each competitor shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
