



## AYC Sailing Center and Marina Guidelines – 2021 Helly Hansen NOOD Regatta

AYC's Sailing Center has a limited number of spots for visiting boat/trailer storage. For NOOD we welcome Etchells, J/22, J/70 & J/80 competitors. Contact the Dockmasters if you would like to check availability and reserve a spot. Boats may arrive no earlier than 24 April and must vacate the Sailing Center by 1200 on Monday, May 3. Please note that the SC lot will have a large number of J/70s competing in their North Americans that unless told otherwise will be staying at the AYC Sailing Center through their event.

- On AYC property including marinas, launch areas and parking lots members & guests should continue to follow suggested social distancing & PPE guidelines.
- Masks must be worn when coming within 6' of AYC staff.

### Facilities: Access to Sailing Center

- Sailing Center Locker Rooms are available 24/7 with an AYC Member access card – paper towel dispensers have been installed outside of the locker rooms to use when touching the exterior door handles prior to entry. During staff hours Locker Rooms will be open and available for visiting NOOD sailors.
- Face coverings must be worn inside of all AYC buildings on the campus.
- Parking at AYC lots is only available to AYC members with valid stickers. In Eastport where the Sailing Center is located there are numerous free parking spots on the surround streets.

### Guidelines: Sailing Center and Marinas

- Members & guests should avoid congregating and maintain 6-foot social distancing
- Handwashing stations are set up at the Annex and Sailing Center for member & guest use.
- No rafting up to keep distance between boaters.
- Once in the water, boats should head off the dock as soon as possible to keep the flow of operation smooth and limit the number of members & their guests gathered in one area.
- Members & guests who dry sail should keep staff hours in mind to ensure they return to dock in a timely manner if they wish to be hauled that day.
