Sailing Instructions Amendment 1

Due to the number of entries, it has been decided that the PHRF Division will be divided into two classes based on PHRF rating. The two PHRF classes will be started separately. Prizes will be awarded to the first, second and third place finishers in each class. However, the two PHRF classes will be scored as a single class for determining the winners of the perpetual trophies.

A. ADD to 5. CLASSES AND CLASS FLAGS

5.3 CLASS NUMBER DESIGNATION

Class 1: Double-handed

Class 2: PHRF A

Class 3: PHRF B

Class 4: IRC

B. Change 9. THE START as follows:

9.1 Friday, August 14

Class 1- Double-handed Warning Signal	1230 hours
Class 2 - PHRF A Warning Signal	1245 hours
Class 3 - PHRF B Warning Signal	1300 hours
Class 4 – IRC Warning Signal	1315 hours
