2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

The location of the official notice board is in the National Yacht Club chart room, on the first floor of the club house.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made a shore will be displayed on the NYC flag pole directly to the west of the clubhouse.

7 RACING AREA

The racing areas will be in Humber bay just west of Toronto Island.

9 MARKS

Marks will be as follows:

| • Windward & Offset Marks | Orange inflatables |

| • Finish Mark | Red inflatable |
| • Change marks | Yellow inflatables |

11 THE START

The starting line will be between the Start mark and the staff displaying the orange flag on the R/C boat.

12 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

12.2 Is replaced with:

If the windward marks (Mark 1 and 1a) are changed they will be replaced with both a windward and offset mark.

12.3 Is replaced with:

If the leeward marks (Mark 2p and 2s) are changed they will be replaced with 2 marks.

13 THE FINISH

The finish line will be between the Finish mark and the staff displaying the orange flag on the R/C boat.

15 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

15.1 Is replaced with:

Protest forms are available at the officer of the day station on the first floor of the NYC clubhouse. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered there within the time limit.

15.4 The protest room is location on the first floor of the NYC clubhouse.

The following is added to Section 15

ARBITRATION

15.9 For a protest between two boats alleging a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31, an arbitration meeting may be held prior to any protest hearing.

15.10 One representative from each boat will meet with the arbitrator. No witnesses will be permitted.

15.11 The arbitrator will advise on whether:

- a) One or both boats should take a penalty;
- b) The protest should be withdrawn; or
- c) The protest should go to the protest committee for a hearing.

15.12 When a boat accepts a penalty or the arbitrator advises that the protest should be withdrawn, the arbitrator will allow the protest to be withdrawn. This changes rule 63.1.

15.12 When a protest is withdrawn, it will not be reopened or made the subject of a request for redress

26 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

- (a) The winner of the regatta will be awarded the Gold Cup Trophy.
- (b) Keeper prizes will be awarded to the top 5 skippers and crew.
