**Schedule:** **Registration and Launching** will be at Deephaven Elementary School on Thursday, June 11<sup>th</sup> from 1:00pm-7:00pm and on Friday from 7:30am-8:30am. In accordance with the terms of our special event permit from the Minnesota DNR and Lake Minnetonka Conservation District; all boats must be washed with a high pressure sprayer to prevent the spread of invasive species. We will have a high pressure sprayer at registration to clean boats before launching.

**Practice Sailing** along with a 3pm practice start will be available during registration hours.

**Competitors' Briefing** will be held at Lighthouse Island (MYC) and by VHF radio on Friday, June 12<sup>th</sup> at 8:30am.

**Race Schedule** Six races are scheduled. The first race is scheduled for a 10:00am warning signal on Friday, June 12. Except when races are sailed back to back, the approximate time of the warning signal for subsequent races will be posted. No races shall start after 12:30pm Sunday June, 14<sup>th</sup>.

**Rules:** The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Prescriptions of US Sailing and the C Class Scantlings as published in the ILYA Rule Book.

**Scoring:** The low point scoring system, RRS A4 shall apply, except that RRS A2 is changed so that each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races unless six or more races are completed. If six or more races are complete, each boat shall discard her worst score, except when prohibited under RRS 90.3(b).

**Eligibility:** The regatta is open to Class C Scows. Helms-persons MUST be Regular Members of the NCSSA. You can become a member by completing and submitting the NCSSA registration form and fee via the NCSSA website ([www.cscow.org](http://www.cscow.org)), or at registration.

**Media:** Competitors give absolute right and permission for video footage or photographs

**Rights:** of themselves or their boat generated during the event to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

**Awards:** NCSSA race winner trophies will be awarded for each race. Trophies will be awarded to the skipper and two crew finishing 1<sup>st</sup> thru 10<sup>th</sup>, and the top Master, Junior and Female Skippers.

**Moorings:** Boat mooring will be available within Carsons Bay. Please bring a sufficient size anchor as well as 40' of line and a buoy. Many C Scows, if not all, will be able to cross tie their boat from the mooring to a local resident's dock and avoid the need for a shuttle boat. (Please be respectful when parking, walking and docking at these private residences.)
