Notice of Race

The Fort Worth Boat Club as the Organizing Authority (OA) cordially invites you to the 2021 Ol' Man of the Sea Regatta on beautiful Eagle Mountain Lake

1. Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, and the class rules of the applicable one-design classes, with the exception of crew weights for the FWBC Club J22 Fleet and J105.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats with a FWBC PHRF rating or one design classes.
- 2.2 All Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form on www.<u>yachtscoring.com</u> and paying the required registration fee.
- 2.3 One-design classes may be declared for fleets with three (3) or more entries.
- 2.4 A Cruising Fleet will be formed for boats interested in casual event.
- 2.5 Boats not sailing in one-design class fleets will be scored using the FWBC PHRF time-on-distance handicapping systems.
- 2.6 FWBC Club J22s can be reserved by qualified members for either 2 crew with no spinnakers or 3 crew with spinnaker, fleets will be formed based on demand as per 2.3.

3. Fees

3.1 The registration fee for this regatta is payable at the time of registration will be as follows \$95 (US) for all boats.

Entries received after 2359 on October 1, 2021 will automatically incur a late fee of \$20.00.

4. Sailing Instructions

4.1 The Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at onsite registration and will be posted on the <u>yachtscoring.com</u> Regatta site prior to onsite registration.

5. Venue and Courses

- 5.1 Fort Worth Boat Club and the racing area are located on Eagle Mountain Lake.
- 5.2 The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward, triangle or olympic style, or point to point distance races using dropped or FWBC permanent racing marks.
- 5.3 Course diagrams will be available in the SIs.

6. Scoring

- 6.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 6.2 The race committee will make every attempt to complete as many as six races.

7. Prizes

7.1 Trophies will be awarded according to the number of boats in a class, to be determined by the Regatta Committee.

8.0 Entertainment and Catering

- 8.1 Breakfast and coffee will be available for competitors on Saturday and Sunday.
- 8.2 Packed lunches will be available by pre-ordering when registering.
- 8.3 Catering will be available throughout the event from the *The Reckless Chicken*



8.4 An OktoberFest event will take place on Saturday 16 October from 6.00 pm on the lawn, with live music by Chasing Rent, festive food from the *The Reckless Chicken*. Reservations can be made when registering or at the Fort Worth Boat Club office.

10.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

11. Insurance

11.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with minimum coverage of \$300,000.00 per incident.

12. Regatta Apparel

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
