

2021 Lake Michigan Clipper Cup Notice of Race Friday, August 6, 2021

The Organizing Authority will be the Clipper Cup Committee with support of the Muskegon Yacht Club and the Port Washington Yacht Club.

1 Rules

The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 Advertising

Will be restricted to Category A

3 Entry

Participation will be split into four divisions:

Spinnaker Division - Competing for Clipper Cup and JC Rillema Perpetual Trophy.

Jib and Main Division - Competing for Bert Smith Perpetual Trophy.

Cruising Division - Competing for Lighthouse Perpetual Trophy.

Multihull Division - Competing for Division Flag and Trophy.

4 Registration and Fees Yachts must submit:

- A. Completed entry form.
- B. Current certificate of insurance with a minimum \$300,000 liability coverage.
- C. Entry Fee is \$110.00.
- D. Yachts competing in the Spinnaker or Jib & Main divisions must submit a <u>current and valid</u> <u>LMPHRF Certificate</u>. Cruising division is available for boats without an LMPHRF certificate. All PHRF division boats and Cruising division boats that submit a valid/current LMPRFH certificate, will be scored using the (HCP) rating.
- E. Competitors must also register at Muskegon Yacht Club. Registration must be completed by 8:00 PM on Thursday, August 5, 2021. Entered yachts that do not register at MYC will be scored DNS and fees will not be refunded.

5 Course

The course will be from Muskegon to Port Washington. Distance used will be 66.9 nautical miles

6 **Protests**

Protests must be submitted in writing to the Clipper Cup Committee not more than two hours after finishing.

7 Decisions of the Jury

Decisions of the Jury are final. Any determination made after the presentation of the awards will have no effect on those awards.

8 Prizes

In addition to the awards mentioned in NOR 3, awards will be presented to the overall race winner (lowest elapsed time mono hull from any fleet), yachts finishing first through fourth in each division (subject to the number of boats in each division) and last yacht to finish.

9 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the Lake Michigan Clipper Cup entirely at their own risk (see RRS rule 3, Decision to race). The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

10 Cruising Division Instructions

The race committee will assign PHRF ratings to the Cruising Division. Acceptance into the Cruising Division will be at the discretion of the Race Committee. There must be at least 3 entrants in the Cruising Division to have a class. All safety requirements must be met. A cruising asymmetric spinnaker (gennaker) may be used but no whisker or spinnaker pole may be used to support the cruising spinnaker. A spinnaker pole or whisker pole may be used to wing out jibs but is restricted in length to the "J" dimension.

11 Registration and Competitors Meeting

It is recommended that the Skipper or a representative attend the Competitors Meeting Thursday, August 5, 2021 at 8:00 PM at Muskegon Yacht Club.

12 Safety

Each boat shall conform to US Coast Guard safety standards and the requirements of a "Category 3 race" as defined in the ISAF Offshore Special Regulations book (available from US Sailing).
