2021 Lake Huron Championship Regatta NOTICE OF RACE August 7th and 8th

1 RULES

- 1.1 The series races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- **1.2** The prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association will apply.
- **1.3** The minimum number of crew per boat is two (2).
- 1.4 The Lake Huron PHRF By-Laws will apply and each boat shall have a current Lake Huron PHRF rating certificate.
- **1.5** The One Design classes shown in the final splits shall comply with their class rules.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats shall display advertising in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20- ISAF Advertising Code.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **3.1** The races are open to all boats that complete the entry form.
- 3.2 Eligible Skippers must complete registration for the series at <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u> website.

4 FEES

4.1 The fee of \$75 *must* be paid on Yachtscoring.com when completing 3.2.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Race dates are Saturday and Sunday, August 7th and 8th.
- **5.2** See Sailing Instructions for scheduled warning signal.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available by August 5th on Yachtscoring.com event page.

7 CLASSES

- 7.1 Classes offered are PHRF and One Design.
- 7.2 Six or more boats and the approval of the Organizing Authority are required to form a class.

8 THE COURSES

- 8.1 Racing will take place in the blue waters of Lower Lake Huron within 2 miles of R4.
- 8.2 The courses will be windward/leeward courses using inflatable drop marks.

9 SCORING

9.1 In accordance with RRS A2, no scores will be excluded.

10 PRIZES

10.1 Prizes will be given to the top three finishers in each class. Top performers will be recognized as well.

11 Dockage

- **11.1** Dockage and mooring will be available at both PHYC and SYC.
- **11.2** PHYC hoist is free of use to competitors, ramp launching available on Black River.
- **11.3** SYC hoist and ramp launching available at no charge.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the races entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the races.

13 INSURANCE
