### 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Item 11.3.1 is added to the sailing instructions.

11.3.1 The starting line may be extended for the T-10 class. If the starting line is extended, starting mark will be the original yellow mark designating the end of the starting line for the T-10 class. The mark used for the start of the J/105 class will be a yellow cylinder. The starting mark designated for the J/105 class is not a mark of the course for the T-10 class. The starting mark designated for the T-10 class is not a mark of the course for the J/105 class.

Item 15.4 is changed to read:

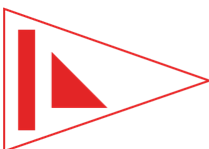
15.4 [NP] Boats that have not finished a race and are delaying the start of the next race may be asked to accept being scored in place at the time of the notification.

Item 18.6 is changed to read:

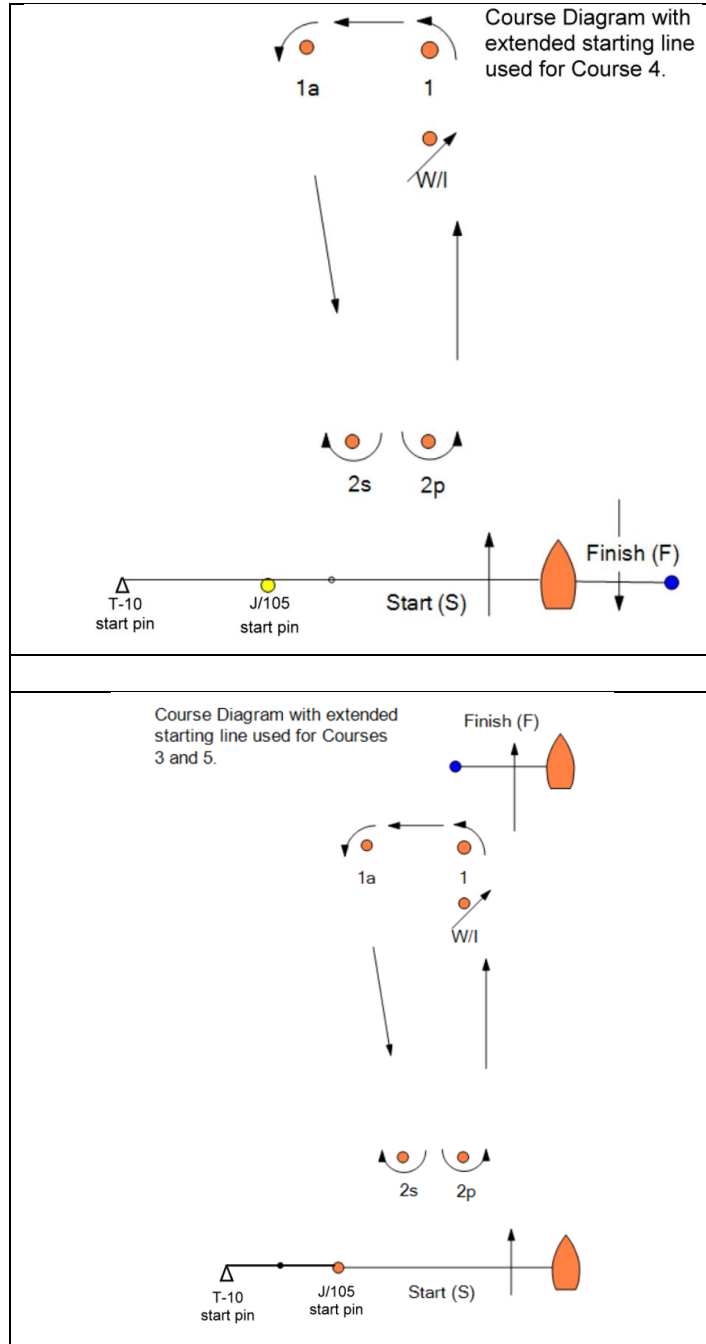
18.6 Wind limits

18.6.1 Sustained winds more than 15 knots or gusts more than 18 knots, boats shall be sailed with only their jib and main. This will be signaled by the signal boat displaying Flag E prior to the warning.

18.6.2 When sustained winds are more than 20 knots or gusts more than 25 knots, no races will be held. If a race has been started and conditions exceed these wind and gust criterion, the races shall be abandoned.
