With Amendment #2, we have added the Green Tetrahedron ("Golf" or "G") to our list of available course marks. The Yellow Tetrahedron ("Kilo" or "K") has been removed from the list.

The use of the "Golf" mark will be only for the PHRF C & PHRF JAM sections in order to provide more options in regards to course configuration & length.

Our intention is to use the mark as a windward mark. Please see the courtesy illustrations attached.

7. COURSES

7.1 Courses will consist of legs marked by the following permanent and temporary buoys referred to by the following terms, including call names and acronym symbol (see Appendix A for details of the temporary marks):

- · Yacht Club club mark (Y)
- · Bryant Park club mark (B)
- · Sandpit club mark (S)
- · Red 8 government mark (R)
- · Orange Tetrahedron (Tango, "T"), inflatable
- · Yellow Tetrahedron (Kilo, "K"), inflatable
- · Orange Cylinder, (Oscar, "O"), inflatable
- · Yellow Cylinder, (Zulu, "Z"), inflatable
- · Pink Ball, (Charlie, "C"), inflatable
- · Orange Cylinder used as Start Line Pin, (X-ray, "X"), inflatable, may also be used as a mark of the course
- 7.2 Communication of Course Selection
 - 7.2.1 The course selection will be displayed from the RC Boat no later than one (1) minute before the 1st warning signal.
 - 7.2.2 Courses will be represented on the course board by the letter abbreviations listed above.
 - 7.2.3 The background of the letter tiles will depict the direction to round the indicated mark red for port, green for starboard
 - 7.2.4 Course selection may also be communicated by VHF radio on Ch. 69 and/or by text as a courtesy.
- 7.3 Sections may be assigned different courses.

7.1 Courses will consist of legs marked by the following permanent and temporary buoys referred to by the following terms, including call names and acronym symbol (see Appendix A for details of the temporary marks):


- · Yacht Club club mark (Y)
- · Bryant Park club mark (B)
- · Sandpit club mark (S)
- · Red 8 government mark (R)
- Orange Tetrahedron (Tango, "T"), inflatable
- Yellow Tetrahedron (Kilo, "K"), inflatable (deleted)
- Green Tetrahedron (Golf, "G"), inflatable used exclusively by the PHRF C and PHRF JAM sections as a primary or secondary windward mark
- · Orange Cylinder, (Oscar, "O"), inflatable

- Yellow Cylinder, (Zulu, "Z"), inflatable
- Pink Ball, (Charlie, "C"), inflatable
- Orange Cylinder used as Start Line Pin, (X-ray, "X"), inflatable, may also be used as a mark of the course
- 7.2 Communication of Course Selection
 - 7.2.1 The course selection will be displayed from the RC Boat no later than one (1) minute before the 1st warning signal.
 - 7.2.2 Courses will be represented on the course board by the letter abbreviations listed above.
 - 7.2.3 The background of the letter tiles will depict the direction to round the indicated mark red for port, green for starboard $\,$
 - 7.2.4 Course selection may also be communicated by VHF radio on Ch. 69 and/or by text as a courtesy.
- 7.3 Sections may be assigned different courses.


One of the likely (but not exclusive) uses of the "Golf" mark as the PHRF C & PHRF JAM windward mark for double windward/leeward

PHRF C & PHRF JAM POSSIBLE USE OF "GOLF" MARK, #2

One of the likely (but not exclusive) uses of the "Golf" mark as the PHRF C & PHRF JAM windward mark for double windward/leeward. The "Tango" mark is the first windward mark, with the "Golf" mark being rounded as the second windward mark on the second upwind leg
