NOTICE OF RACE

1) RULES:

- a) The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing,
- b) The US Sailing Prescription Appendix V shall apply
- c) The penalty for breaking a non-Part 2 or class rule may be less than DSQ at the discretion of the Protest Committee, and may be a warning (DP).

2) SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

a) The Sailing Instructions will be available no later than 1900 on Wednesday, June 16, 2021 online at https://www.yachtscoring.com/ and at Barrington Yacht Club

3) COMMUNICATIONS:

a) The official regatta website is located at: https://www.yachtscoring.com/

4) ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY:

- a) The regatta is open to all current members of the Sunfish Class.
- b) Competitors should be enrolled in the class prior to registering for this Regatta.
 - i) Go to: https://sunfish.wildapricot.org/join-us
- Online entry is required. Completed entries must be received no later than 1800 Thursday, June 17, 2021.
- d) Online registration and electronic entry fee payment are available at: https://www.yachtscoring.com/
- e) Paper entries will not be accepted.
- f) To be considered an entry in this event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5) FEES:

- a) Registration Fee is \$75.00. Completed entries must be received no later than 1800 Thursday, June 17, 2021
- b) Online entries received after this date will be accepted if they include a \$25.00 late fee.
- **6) ADVERTISING**: Advertising is restricted per ISAF Regulation 20.2.

7) SCHEDULE:

- a) Saturday, June 19.
 - i) 0900 Skippers Meeting
 - ii) 1100 1st Race Signal.
 - iii) no race will start after 1700.
- b) Sunday, June 20.
 - i) 1000 1st Race Signal.
 - ii) no race will start after 1530
 - iii) Award Presentation after racing.
- c) It is anticipated that 7 10 races will be held over the two days of racing.

8) EQUIPMENT INSPECTION.

- a) All boats must comply with class measurement rules.
- b) Boats may be inspected at any time.
- 9) VENUE: Off Barrington Town Beach, and northeast of the shipping channel.
 - a) Staging area will be the west side of the beach parking lot.
 - b) Boats may be stored on the beach Saturday night.

10) COURSES:

a) Courses will be windward-leeward, triangle, or a combination thereof.

11) PENALTY SYSTEM:

a) RRS 44.1 as modified by Appendix V applies

12) SCORING:

- a) The Low Point Scoring System in Rule A4 will apply.
- b) One race will constitute a series.
- c) If 6 or more races are completed, each boat's regatta score will be her total points excluding her one worst score. This changes Rule A2.

13) SAFETY:

a) RRS 40.1 **Personal Flotation Device** applies.

14) AWARDS:

- a) 1st through 5th places.
- b) Top Junior: 18th birthday after 12/31/21.
- c) Top Narragansett Bay based competitor.
- d) Top Female
- e) Top sailor: 50 or older on January 1, 2021.

15) RISK STATEMENT

a) .RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone. By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
