

# Notice of Race



## Tillo Cup Spring Windsurfing Regatta Hosted by Biscayne Bay Yacht Club May 14 – 16, 2021

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. **Competitors shall follow all Biscayne Bay Yacht Club COVID-19 guidelines.**
- 1.2. **All Competitors must present a negative COVID-19 test administered no earlier than May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021.**
- 1.3. The Organizing Authority is US Windsurfing.
- 1.4. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the RRS and Appendix B - Windsurfing Fleet Racing Rules.
- 1.5. No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.6. If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.

### 2. ADVERTISING

Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1. The participating **Classes** include:
  - 3.1.1. **Open WindFoil** – Max Sail Size 9.0m
  - 3.1.2. **Youth WindFoil**s - Youth Boys & Girls with Max Board Width 91cm (Divisions below)
  - 3.1.3. **Techno 293** – Youth Boys & Girls (Divisions below)
  - 3.1.4. **Green Fleet** – Open to all competitors.
- 3.2. Age **Divisions** for Youth WindFoil and Techno 293:
  - 3.2.1. WindFoil (U16) shall be under 16 years of age on December 31st, 2021
  - 3.2.2. WindFoil (U13) shall be under 13 years of age on December 31st, 2021
  - 3.2.3. Techno (13) shall be under 13 years of age on December 31st, 2021
  - 3.2.4. Techno (15) shall be under 15 years of age on December 31st, 2021
  - 3.2.5. Techno (17) shall be under 17 years of age on December 31st, 2021
- 3.3. A minimum of 3 competitors is required to constitute a Division.

### 4. REGISTRATION

- 4.1. Competitors may register online at <https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=14586>
- 4.2. Entry is not final until registration is complete and all entry fees have been paid.
- 4.3. **A Negative COVID-19 Test administered no later than May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021 must be presented at registration.**
- 4.4. Parental Consent and Waiver must be completed for those under age of 18.

## 5. FEES

- 5.1. Entry fee adults 21 year or older \$120 Fri/Sat/Sun or \$85 Sat/Sun racing.
- 5.2. Entry fee youth under 21 years old \$75
- 5.3. Online entry will close on May 13, 2021 at 8:00pm ET for all Classes.
- 5.4. A late fee of \$25 applies after May 13th.
- 5.5. No fee for coach or support boats.
- 5.6. All fees must be paid in US Dollars, and taxes are included.
- 5.7. No refunds.

## 6. RACE FORMAT

- 6.1. At the discretion of the Race Committee, some Classes may race together but will be scored separately.
- 6.2. Divisions within the Class may race together but will be scored separately, depending upon entry numbers.
- 6.3. The intention is to run no more than 12 races for each Class/Division.
- 6.4. Three races constitute a regatta for each Class/Division.

### 8. EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

8.1. Unless otherwise directed by the organizing authority, boards and equipment shall be stored, launched and retrieved from the designated area at the event site.

### 9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions (SI's) will be available on the Official Yacht Scoring Notice Board

### 10. COURSES

Course races are planned.

### 11. VENUE

Competitors will sail from the Biscayne Bay Yacht Club. The Regatta will be on the Biscayne Bay.

### 12. SCORING

12.1 Scoring will be according to the low point system in Appendix A.

12.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

12.3 When 3 or fewer races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her races. When 4 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When 5-8 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores. When 9-12 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst three scores. This amends Appendix A.

### 13. SUPPORT BOATS

13.1. All coach and support boats shall monitor and respond to US VHF radio traffic.

13.2. All coach and support boats must be registered and present evidence of valid third party insurance at the race office.

### 14. SAFETY

14.1. The use of personal flotation devices is required. Every competitor and coach/support boat member shall wear above the waist, a jacket, harness or impact vest with minimum buoyancy of 4kg uninflated in freshwater except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.

14.2. Helmets are required for all Windfoiling Classes.

14.3. An adult (parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of any competitor who is a minor below 18 years of age.

## 15. PRIZES

15.1. Prizes will be awarded based upon participation.

## 16. RISK STATEMENT

- 16.1. Rule 4 of the RRS states: "The responsibility for a sailor's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
- 16.2. Each sailor is aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves and their equipment to such inherent risk while taking part in the event;
- 16.3. Each sailor is responsible for the safety of themselves and their equipment and other property whether afloat or ashore;
- 16.4. Each sailor accepts responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- 16.5. Each sailor must ensure their equipment is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- 16.6. The provision of a race management team, safety boats and other officials and volunteers by the race organizer does not relieve any sailor of their own responsibilities;
- 16.7. The provision of safety boat support is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
- 16.8. The fact that the Race Committee conducts inspections, or not, of equipment does not reduce the responsibilities of each competitor set out in this Notice of Race.

## 17. RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
