Boats shall attempt to hail the race committee over VHF 69 when approximately 3-5 miles from the finish or call Brent Bacon at 813.363.6935 If the race committee is not on station at the finish, the US Sailing prescription to RRS 34 applies. Take your GPS time when finish mark bears 270 degrees magnetic within 100 feet of Finish mark (port). Skippers taking their own time, please take a picture of your GPS with time and Lat/Long position and deliver to RC upon docking or via text to Brent Bacon.
