NOTICE OF RACE

**The Duck Island Yacht Club ("DIYC") is the Organizing
Authority ("OA").**

Dates: Single Series: Thursdays; June 24, July 1, 8, 15, 22, 29, Aug 5, 12, 19, 26

One Design Race Series: We are expecting JY-15 and Laser classes again this year. We are also looking to expand to other one design classes so all are welcome to come. See 2.3 below.

1. Rules

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024*, *Prescriptions of US Sailing*, the *DIYC Thursday One Design Sailing Instructions*, and the version of this *Notice of Race* that is posted on the YachtScoring event page.
- 1.2. The Sailing Instructions change the following rules: *Rule 35*-Time limit is by boat, *Rule 62.1(a)*-Restriction on redress, *Race Signals*-Postponement signaled ashore, *Appendix A*-Provision for absence in attending away class events and *Rule 81* – Indemnification or Hold Harmless Agreements.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. Entries must be created online at www.yachtscoring.com.
- 2.2. All entrants and crew must abide by the DIYC *COVID-19 Racers Advisory & Protocols* with the exception of masks, which are not required to be worn on the water, and must read and sign the *DIYC COVID-19 Waiver/Release* which will be available in the document section of the YachtScoring event page.
- 2.3. These races will be for all interested one design classes, 3 or more paid boats to make a class.

3. Fees

3.1. Entry Fee

- 3.2. *The USSA discount is for entrants who are current US Sailing members.
- 3.3. Fees include boat storage at DIYC. All boats and trailers must be removed within two weeks following the last race of the Series it was registered for.

4. Sailing Instructions

- 4.1. Will be available at least one week before the First Warning on the YachtScoring event page.
- 4.2. Limited copies will be placed in the blue box next to the bulletin board described below.
- 4.3. Notices to Competitors will be posted on the YachtScoring event page and on the Race Committee bulletin board located below the deck in the front of the clubhouse building, Hammock Road South, Westbrook, CT

5. Start

- 5.1. In the vicinity of Duck Island Roads, Westbrook, CT.
- 5.2. The First Warning Signal is scheduled at 1830.

6. Courses

- 6.1. Will be selected immediately prior to each race by the Race Committee, and signaled in accordance with the Sailing Instructions.
- 6.2. The Race Committee may conduct two or more races for some classes, weather permitting.

7. Scoring

- 7.1. The low-point scoring system per RRS Appendix A will be used for series overall results in each class.
- 7.2. Rule A5.3 will apply for series scoring.
- 7.3. A minimum of 70% of the races must be completed by a competitor to qualify for series points awards.
- 7.4. 20% of the races scored will be excluded.
- 7.5. Boats that travel to an away regatta will receive an average score for missed races, one event per series.

8. Results and Prizes:

- 8.1. Results will be posted on the event page of YachtScoring.
- 8.2. Series prizes will be awarded to the appropriate finishers in each class at the DIYC annual awards banquet at the conclusion of the racing season as follows.
 - 8.2.1. 1st for a class of 3 boats,
 - 8.2.2. 1st and 2nd for a class of 4 boats,
 - 8.2.3. 1st, 2nd and 3rd for a class of 5 or more boats.
