

**Helly Hansen Sailing World Regatta
Chicago Yacht Club, Chicago IL
June 11, 2022**

**REMOTE CONTROL RACING
SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing World is the organizing authority (OA) of this event. Chicago Yacht Club is the host club and will provide race management. This is a US Sailing sanctioned event.

1. RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

1.2 RRS Appendix E will apply.

1.3 DragonForce 65 Restricted Class Rules will apply.

1.4 [NP] All boats are required to abide by the state and local laws, guidelines, and recommendations as well as the host club's restrictions regarding the COVID-19 virus. Links to these documents will be posted on the Official Notice Board as they become available.

1.5 A boat that may have broken rule 31 while racing does not have to take any penalty turns and violations are not protestable by competitors. Rule 31 is still in effect. This changes RRS E4.3 and 60.1.

2. CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Any change to the sailing instructions can be made orally at the time of racing.

2.2 Any change made orally, which applies to the series shall be subsequently posted online as an amendment.

3. SCHEDULE

3.1 Onsite check-in will take place starting 30 minutes prior to the first warning.

3.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1800.

3.3 It is the intention of the Race Committee to run up to six (6) races.

4. RACING AREA

The racing area will be Monroe Harbor near/around the Chicago Yacht Club.

5. REGISTRATION

5.1 Entry fee is \$20.00.

5.2 All boats must have sail #s, in accordance with the DragonForce 65 Sail Numbering Diagram. (See Appendix B).

6. THE COURSE/MARKS

6.1 The course diagram is shown in Appendix A and it will be 1 lap.

7. THE START/FINISH

7.1 The start sequence shall be a 2-minute sequence. ***This changes RRS E3.4.***

7.2 Start and finish line are the same.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1 Penalties while racing: US Sailing Prescription V1 (Penalty at the Time of the Incident) shall apply.

8.2 Penalties after racing: RRS Appendix T Arbitration will apply.

9. TIME LIMITS

The time limit will be 15 minutes.

10. COACHING

10.1 Chicago Yacht Club may provide on the water coaching during the racing. This changes rule 41 and E4.2.

10.2 [NP] A competitor shall not seek redress for failure to receive specific coaching instructions or

as the result of the consequences of a particular coaching instruction. This changes rule 62.1(a).

11. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

11.1 Protests and requests for redress or reopening a hearing shall be delivered to the protest desk at Monroe Station within the appropriate time limit.

11.2 A boat's protest time limit is 10 minutes after the last boat finishes for the day.

12. SCORING

12.1 A boat's score will be the total of her race scores. This changes rule A2.

12.2 One completed race constitutes a regatta.

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at the Helly Hansen Sailing World Regatta Series Saturday night social.

14. RISK, DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY, WAIVERS, PERSONAL CONDUCT

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Acceptance of the Rules. The OA and CYC will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14.2 The destruction of property, the breach of reasonable standards of good sportsmanship by any skipper, or any other person associated with the boat, or the failure of any of those persons to comply with the state and local laws, guidelines and recommendations as well as the host club's restrictions or with any reasonable request of the Organizing Authorities, Race Officers, Regatta Committee members, or their representatives, may result in the disqualification of the boat, and its exclusion from the regatta.
