

2021 Fall Foil Racing Regatta

St. Petersburg, Florida

All Competitors shall follow current SPYC, City, State and Federal requirements for Health and Safety

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the RRS 2021- 2024, including Appendix F and Appendix B
- 1.2 The organizing authority (OA) is St. Petersburg Yacht Club
- 1.3 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta entries will include Open Kite Hydrofoil and iQFOIL
- 2.2 No entries accepted after 2000 hrs on Thursday Nov 4, 2021, without approval by the Principal Race Officer
- 2.3 Registration is done online through Yacht Scoring and can also be found at SPYC website under “Regattas”
- 2.4 Competitors under the age of 18 shall be required to complete the following: **On line at Yacht Scoring:**
 - **Parental Release for Youth Participation In SPYC Events Waiver**
- 2.5 An entry is not considered complete until both the entry form, fee and waiver have been received through Yacht Scoring.
- 2.6 Entries are limited to a total of 30 competitors, after 30 entries a wait list will be created. Kite entries designate if you will sail in A Division 2x around the course or B Division 1x around the course. Both Kite Divisions will start together. IQFoil entries designate your sail size. All IQFoil entries will start together.

3 FEES

The entry fee is \$100. A refundable deposit of \$20 cash/check or credit card will be collected with distribution of assigned Pinni's. Once Pinni is returned at the end of the event the deposit is refunded.

5 VENUE

The Skyway Bridge East Side North end on Pinellas County side if an Easterly breeze is present or Pass A Grille Beach, Pass a Grille, Florida when any Westerly, SW, W, NW is present.

6 COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be described in the sailing instructions.

7 ADVERTISING

7.1 World Sailing Regulation 20 - Advertising Code- shall apply.

7.2 Competitors may be required to carry advertising for event and class sponsors on their boards, kiteboards, sails, lines, and on a Pinni, if supplied by the OA.

8 IDENTIFICATION

Every competitor is required to wear the official event Lycra/Pinni with their personal identification number whenever going afloat during the event.

9 BUOYANCY

9.1 The use of personal flotation devices is prescribed, every competitor and support boat crewmember shall wear, above the waist, a jacket, harness, or vest with a minimum buoyancy of 4kg uninflated in fresh water.

9.2 Personal buoyancy and helmets is mandatory for all competitors in the iQFOiL class and those under 18 years of age in all classes.

10 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on Yacht Scoring as the official notice board no later than the first competitor's briefing.

11 SCORING

11.1 The low point system of Appendix A will apply.

11.2 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta, scores will be posted on Yacht Scoring.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 The sailing instructions may alternatively specify that competitors may choose between the turn penalty and a scoring penalty. This may change RRS F44.

12.2 Discretionary penalties and arbitration may be used if outlined in the sailing instructions.

13 PRIZES

Awards shall be given based on participation.

14 DISCLAIMERS OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, "DECISION TO RACE." The OA, the sponsors, the race committee, officers and board of directors of the SPYC, and all those involved in these organizations will not accept any responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14.2 The Skipper/Owner of each boat participating in the Regatta shall be responsible for their behavior on the water and while ashore. The failure of any person to comply with all federal, state, and local

government regulations as well as the St Petersburg Yacht Club policies or with any reasonable request of the Organizing Authority, Race Officers, or their representatives may result in the disqualification of the boat and its exclusion from the regatta. This modifies RRS 76.

15 TELEVISION AND MEDIA

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant the organizing authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said event as defined in the notice of race and sailing instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
