

Safety and Emergency Protocol RTI 2022

The safety of participants is of utmost importance to Edgartown Yacht Club, the Organizing Authority of the 'Round-the-Island Race.

In the case of an emergency on the water, contact the Coast Guard or local Harbormaster, then notify the Race Committee at 508-627-4364, or on VHF Ch 72.

Martha's Vineyard's waters are included in the US Coast Guard's Southeastern New England Sector. The western side of the island is the responsibility of the Menemsha Station, and the eastern side is the responsibility of the Woods Hole Station.
