HOOK Cruising Division Guidelines

- 1. All Cruising Division boats will use the PRHF Time on Distance (TOD) as the boat rating.
- 2. The warning signal for Cruising Division boats will be 830 CDT. All Cruising Division boats must finish within 56 hours from the PHRF 1 Division start (in other words, the last start).
- 3. Motoring is permitted (see 5. below). All boats must record total motoring time. Motoring time must be submitted within one hour of finishing. The total motoring time will be added to the elapsed time at the finish to give each boat its "true" elapsed time.
- 4. Cruising Division boats are allowed to dock and skippers and crew may leave their boats.
- 5. MOTORING IS NOT PERMITTED during the following portions of the race:
 - a. During the starting sequence.
 - b. From Buoy # 1 off of Chambers Island to the finish line.
- 6. Cruising Division awards: flags for first, second, third place. Cruising division boats are ineligible for Overall and Line Honors awards.
