NOTICE OF REGATTA SERIES Amendment #1

- 1) Notice of Regatta Series, Section 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY, part 3.2 is deleted and replaced with the following:
- 3.2 A Corinthian division will be established. The division will be open to boats whose skipper and crew hold a valid Group 1 Classification in accordance with ISAF Regulation 22 Sailor Classification Code. Sailor Classification Codes will be checked for each crew member in each regatta at the following date and time:

Etchells Pacific Coast Championships – Saturday, May 14, 2022 at 1800 NOOD/Bill Bennet Memorial – Saturday, May 14, 2022 at 1800 Etchells Midwinters West Saturday, May 14, 2022 at 1800 Orca Bowl – Saturday, May 14, 2022 at 1800

Failure of a crew member to confirm to with ISAF Regulation 22 by the specified date will be grounds for removal from West Coats Spring Series Corinthian division. (Apply here: https://www.sailing.org/classification).

Reasoning: Due to continuing lag times with World Sailing reviewing and assigning classifications codes, NoR 3.2 has been modified.

- 2) Notice of Regatta Series, Section 12 Support Boats, part 12.3 is modified in bold/underlined text as follows:
- 12.3 Competitors shall have no communication with, and boats shall not be tied to, coach or support boats from 1120 each race day until racing has been concluded for the day. In the event of a postponement on shore, competitors shall have no communications with, and boats shall not be tied to, coach or support boats more than 90 minutes after the AP ashore is lowered. The time for AP down will be posted as a courtesy on the Notice Board located on the east side, of the Sailing Center. The Race Committee will make an announcement regarding this timing on the VHF Race channel. Between races, coach and support boats shall not approach, communicate with or transfer provisions or equipment to or from their supported boats unless in a medical or emergency requirement threatening the health of the crew or the flotation of the boat and only with the expressed permission of the Race Committee.

Reasoning: This allows boats to utilize private tows in the event of a delay onshore.
