ILYA Bayweek Regatta Aug. 5-7 2022

Cruising Class:

- 1) Cruising Class shall be open to boats wishing to sail on the JAM/Cruising racing courses around the islands.
- 2) Cruising Class shall sail one race per day.
- 3) Cruising Class shall start after JAM Class and have a 5 minute window in which to start (cross start line) and have their actual start time recorded as the time of day they cross the start line. Any boat starting more than 5 minutes after the start will be given as start time of start plus 5:00 minutes.
- 4) Boats registering for the Cruising Class may enter without a PHRF certificate if they have a boat of recognized construction and rigging with a standard PHRF rating number. Except however, if they wish to claim any "cruising credits" or modifications, then they must present a valid PHRF certificate verifying said cruising credits.
- 5) All Cruising entrants should sail with Dacron sails only. No aramid fiber sail (Carbon, Kevlar, Mylar) should be used during Cruising Class races.
- 6) The Organizing Authority shall have the right to remove any yacht from the Cruising fleet, that does not fit within the spirt of a Cruising class yacht.

Singlehanded Racing Class:

- 1) Boats choosing to race as Singlehanded shall start after the PHRF classes in that start area.
- 2) The Singlehanded class will race one race per day.
- 3) Courses for the Singlehanded class shall be determined separately from the courses being sailed by the PHRF fleet. Courses will generally be in and around the Lake Erie islands area.
