



NOTICE OF RACE

*Updated on March 15. Updates in red.

Regatta activities shall be carried out in accordance with the provisions concerning the fight against and the containment of the spread of Covid 19 issued by FIV, which the Organizing Authority shall be obliged to respect and enforce, and to which the participating members shall comply under the supervision of the Organizing Authority itself. Any cases of Covid 19 that may be detected during the event will be reported by the Organizing Authority to the relevant Health Authorities.

Preamble. The Organizing Authority is Federazione Italiana Vela, that delegates Yacht Club Isole di Toscana, in collaboration with ClubSwan 50 Class, ClubSwan 36 Class, Swan 45 Class and ClubSwan Racing.

1. RULES

This event will be governed by:

- (a) the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS),
- (b) the ClubSwan 50, ClubSwan 36 and Swan 45 Class Rules.
- (c) ClubSwan 50 the World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations Category 4, subject to possible amendments by class rules.
- (d) ClubSwan 36 the World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations Appendix B For Inshore Racing, subject to possible amendments by class rules.
- (e) RRS 47 is in force (see NOR 19)
- (f) The Prescriptions of the FIV 2, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10, 11 to the RRS will apply. Find the Prescriptions at this link: <u>https://www.sailing.org/tools/documents/20172020ITAPrescriptions-[22391].pdf</u> Spare.
- (g) In the event of a discrepancy between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions take precedence. (this changes RRS rule 63.7).







- (h) The classes could sail under an Umpiring system which will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.
- (i) [DP][NP] The event is also subject to the PROTOCOL REGULATING THE MEASUREMENT FOR COVID-19 CONTRAST AND CONTAINMENT that might be in force at the time of the event. In the case of an infringement to the protocol, a 10% penalty could be applied, given the entity of the infringement. The percentage is calculated on the scoring of the boat in any disputed races of the day when the infringement occurred or, in case of an infringement away from racing, the penalty will be applied in the race nearest in time to that of the incident, as per RRS 64.2.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTION

SIs will be available at registration from Monday 25 April 2022, and will be posted on the event website.

No paper SIs will be available, this modifies Appendix "L" of RRS Preamble.

4. ELEGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the ClubSwan 50, ClubSwan 36 and Swan 45 Class, with valid Measurement Certificate and Measurement Forms.
- 4.2 The World Sailing Eligibility Code (WS Regulation 19), and the Sailors Categorization Code (WS Regulation 22) shall apply.
- 4.3 Crew lists and World Sailing Sailor IDs for all crew, as well as declarations of alternate, substitute and relief helmsmen shall be submitted by email or through YachtScoring to the Class Secretariat no later than Tuesday, 12 April 2022:

- 4.4 Crew Lists will be displayed on the Official Notice Board within 20:00 on Tuesday, 26 April.
- 4.5 The Classification Protest Time Limit will be at 10:00 on Wednesday 27 April.
- 4.6 Eligible boats may enter through their Class Secretariat. Details will be made available.
- 4.7 The full entry shall be received by the Class no later than 26 March 2022, accompanied by the required entry fee.





4.8 **ITALIAN SAILORS ONLY**: *I concorrenti italiani dovranno essere in possesso della tessera FIV in corso di validità, comprese le prescrizioni sanitarie.*

5. ENTRY FEE

The entry fees will be as stated for The Nations League 2022 fee. For more details, contact your Class Secretariat.

6. ADVERTISING

- 6.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with WS Regulation 20.
- 6.2 Boats may be required to display advertising and bow numbers chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.
- 6.3 Italian sailors aiming to display advertising should display the *Licenza FIV* valid for 2022.

* limitations on number of persons attending might be applied, due to Covid 19 protocols that might be ruling at the time of the event.

- 7.2 The scheduled time of warning signal for the first race is 12:00.
- 7.3 A maximum of 10 races are scheduled, of which at least 1 has to be completed by each class for the event to be valid. There will be no discard.
- 7.4 No race shall start after 16.00 hours on Saturday 30 April.
- 7.5 The OA and/or RC reserve the right to modify the program because of weather conditions or for any other reason.





8. SCORING

The scoring system will be the Low Point Scoring System described in Appendix A4 of the RRS will apply. The total score of each boat will be the overall sum of all sailed races – there will be no discard.

9. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

Boats competing in the event will be subject to inspection before the event begins; random measurement checks will be set during the event.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 of the RRS is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

11. VENUE

- 11.1 The venue will be Yacht Club Isole di Toscana Marina di Scarlino Località Puntone – 58020 Scarlino (GR) ITALY
- 11.2 The race area will be in the waters off Marina di Scarlino, Follonica Gulf. A diagram of the Race Area will be attached to the SI.

12. THE COURSE

The course will be shown in details in the SI and will be a windward/leeward type of course. It could be a quadrilateral with inner loop/outer loop.

13. SPECTATOR BOATS

Spectator boats shall register with the OA, filling the form available on the online Official Notice Board and will have to comply with their Class Rules. Any infringement to the RRS could be reported to the Jury, that could open an hearing based on 64,4 RRS.

14. COMPETITOR DRONES

- 14.1 Teams or their representatives shall not fly drones over the Swan Tuscany Challenge shore base or over the race area during racing days without complying with local legislation and in any case unless prior written approval by the organizer has been obtained.
- 14.2 The approval granted at sole discretion of the organizer may impose limitation on where and when to fly, in accordance with the Class Rules.
- 14.3 At any time the risk and responsibility for flying any drone is with the person flying the drone and images made inside the race area shall be shared with the organizer, race committee or jury at reasonable request.

15. BERTHING

Boats whose entry has been confirmed for the regatta, will have a berthing place reserved, free of charge (included in the entry fee) from Sunday April 24 at 12:00 to Sunday May 1st at 12:00. For any further needs, concerning

16. PRIZES

The following prizes will be awarded:

- (a) 1st, 2nd, 3rd of each class;
- (b) Best-placed nation.

Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA. Details will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

17. HAUL OUT RESTRICTIONS

The boats shall not be hauled out during the event, starting from Wednesday 27 April at 09:30, unless they have been authorized by the Technical Committee.

18. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) and any person or entity involved in the organization of the event will not accept any liability for loss, damage, injury or nuisances to people or things, both on the water or ashore, occurring as a result of taking part in the event announced in this Notice of Race, whether or not they are consequence of any proper or improper action of the OA and any person or entity involved in the organization.

By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity that carries risks. These risks include the possibility of dealing with strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in the weather, breakdowns / damage to equipment, manouvering mistakes, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance due to yacht instability and fatigue with resulting in an increased risk of injury. The risk of permanent and serious injuries or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes is inherent in the sport of sailing.

Competitors and their support persons participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3 (decision to race).

19. ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSABILITY

Recalling the Basic Principle that mentions: "Participants are encouraged to minimize any adverse environmental impact of the sport of sailing", we recommend the utmost attention to environmental protection in all moments that accompany the practice of the sport of sailing before, during and after the event. In particular, attention is drawn to RRS 47 - Waste Disposal - which verbatim states: "Competitors and their support people shall not intentionally







put trash in the water. This rule applies at all times while afloat. The penalty for a breach of this rule may be less than disqualification.".

20. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.500.000 Euro per incident or equivalent.

21. CHANGES TO THE NOTICE OF RACE

The organisation reserves itself the right to change this Notice of Race. Any change made to this Notice of Race prior to the 25 April 2022, will be published on the event's website (according to RRS 88.2).

22. SOCIAL FUNCTIONS

Further details on Social Functions, if admitted by ruling FIV PROTOCOL REGULATING THE MEASUREMENT FOR COVID-19 CONTRAST AND CONTAINMENT, will be posted on the event web-site.
