Notice of Race with Amendment No. 1

The notation "[NP]" in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. [NP] Eastport Yacht Club (EYC) recommends that each competitor review and prepare their boat to the U.S. Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements, Nearshore. A copy of the Nearshore requirements is available at www.eastportyc.org/racing, located under "Racing Resources."
- 1.3. [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official. Failure to comply may be misconduct. Reasonable actions by event officials to implement COVID-19 guidance, protocols or legislation, even if they later prove to have been unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1. The sailing instructions will be available by 1400 hours on Saturday, 12 November 2022 at <u>www.eastportyc.org/leftover-bowl.</u>

3 COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1. The online official notice board is located at <u>www.eastportyc.org/leftover-bowl.</u>
- 3.2. [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channels 9, 13, 16, and 73.
- 3.3. On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio.
- 3.4. [DP] Except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. There will be three classes: Non-Spinnaker, Spinnaker, and Harbor 20.
- 4.2. Boats in the Non-Spinnaker and Spinnaker handicap classes will be assigned by the Organizing Authority (OA) a Time-on-Time (ToT) rating based on the available information about the boat. The rating assignment is final.
- **4.3.** The OA reserves the right to subdivide the handicap classes, depending upon the number of entries and/or the ratings range.
- 4.4. Eligible boats may enter the event by registering online at <u>www.eastportyc.org/leftover-bowl</u>.

4.5. To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5 FEES

- 5.1. The entry fee is \$40.
- 5.2. A 50% entry fee refund will be provided if a request to withdraw from the race is received by 2000 hours on Saturday, 19 November 2022.

6 EVENT FORMAT

6.1. One (1) race is scheduled.

7 SCHEDULE

8 VENUE

- 8.1. The event venue will be EYC), 317 First Street, Annapolis, MD, 21403. EYC extends the courtesy of its bar and galley to race participants.
- 8.2. The racing area will be on the Chesapeake Bay, in the vicinity of Severn River G "9" QG as shown in NOR Attachment 1.

9 COURSES

9.1. Competitors will sail a fixed mark course on the Severn River.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1. RRS US Sailing Prescription Appendix V, Alternative Penalties, will apply.
- 10.2. Hearings conducted in accordance with the rules of RRS Part 5, [Hearings & Decisions] will be virtual hearings and parties, parties' representatives and witnesses to such hearings shall have access to a device that has internet accessibility with audio and video capability; parties and witnesses must use audio and video to appear before a hearing panel unless advised otherwise by the hearing panel. See *Eastport YC Online Hearing Guidelines* posted on the Official Notice Board.

11 SCORING

- 11.1. Boats in the handicap classes will be scored in accordance with a ToT calculation.
- 11.2. Boats in the Harbor 20 class will be scored in their order of finish.
- 11.3. RRS 90.3(e) will apply with the time limit changed to seven (7) days. This changes RRS 90.3(e).
- 11.4. RRS A5.3 does not apply.

12 RISK STATEMENT

12.1. Boats participate in the Leftover Bowl entirely at their own risk; see RRS 3, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority (OA) will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

13 INSURANCE

13.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.

14 PRIZES

- 14.1. Prizes are based on leftover and unclaimed trophies from previous year(s) hence, the name of the event. Prizes will be at the discretion of the Race Committee, based on the quantity of leftover prizes.
- 14.2. The EYC Golden Shoes award will be presented to the best-dressed boat/crew.
- 14.3. The rubber chicken award will be presented to the boat that finishes last.
- 14.4. Additional awards may be presented at the discretion of the OA.
